D.1.2 BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

Please briefly present your organization/the group
What are the organization's main activities?

Education Culture and Innovative Projects Association is a non-governmental organization founded in March 2024 with the registry number 71-009-054 in Kırıkkale by young people interested in education, culture and projects. The association continues its activities in Kırıkkale Kızılırmak neighborhood.

Individuals who are members of the association receive free sports, music (vocals and playing instruments), painting, theatre and handicraft training from teachers who are members of the association and are experts in their fields.

We organize cultural trips with our youth to different parts of Turkey. Our association has over 85 members from all around Kırıkkale, each of whom are of different ages and come from different walks of life . 35 of our members are teachers. 6 of our teacher members are Physical Education teachers. Our other members are students and from other professional groups.

28 of the association members have athlete and player licenses in many different sports such as football, basketball, volleyball, chess, bowling, bocce, darts, korfbal, orienteering and badminton. We also have association members who can play instruments such as kanun, guitar, baglama and ney at an advanced level.

for Education, Culture and Innovative Projects is to provide and promote mobility opportunities to help young people and members develop their work or study skills. It undertakes various initiatives that promote and develop active European citizenship, intercultural communication, musical and sports skills, social integration, media and journalism.

The association also works with substance and technology addicts, disabled, refugee, immigrant, minority and disadvantaged youth. Our target group is primarily young people with limited opportunities between the ages of 13-30. The association is also active in the field of new technologies and safe Internet use for young people.

It is to promote actions and activities aimed at helping young people develop a better life for themselves and their peers, raising awareness, helping public institutions on specific issues related to young people, developing partnerships in the field of Erasmus+ and ensuring the participation of young people.

One of our main goals is to include disadvantaged youth through different methods such as sports, music, theater, dance and painting and to transfer their deepened original expression to humanity . In order to achieve our goals, we cooperate with families, local governments, municipalities, primary schools, high schools, civil society organizations, associations, foundations, universities and NGOs and develop projects with them. We organize sports competitions such as chess, indoor football and volleyball among our members.

- Encouraging creativity among young people;
- Involving young people with fewer opportunities in international projects;
- Supporting and encouraging local initiatives;
- Supporting youth participation and volunteering for the benefit of communities;
- Fighting racism, discrimination and corruption.
- Promotion and dissemination of culture at the international level.
- Promoting the values of tolerance, respect, equal opportunities and human rights.
- To encourage the lifelong learning process.
- To contribute to a more peaceful, solidarity-based, egalitarian, inclusive and innovative world.
- To contribute to the development of healthier individuals by encouraging young people to do

sports.

- Using art (through community practices) as a therapeutic tool (Art Therapy; Music Therapy)
- To raise awareness about the importance of art and cultural development.
- Supporting the actions of a local, regional and global community.
- To establish and maintain connections with other cultural and artistic communities at home and abroad.
- To preserve and nourish the folklore tradition through songs and dances.

One of the most interesting features of our association is that artists who play instruments such as kanun, violin, ney, oud and piano interpret folk melodies without altering their essence, without interfering with the original characteristics of folk songs.

We have 7 young members in our group who come from the Abdal culture, such as Hacı Taşan and Neşet ERTAŞ.

What are the activities and experience of the organization in youth work? Please provide information on your organisation's / group's regular youth work activities.

Our association has implemented many local projects in a short time since its establishment . However, although our association does not have international project experience, around 10 of our association members have gained experience in this regard by taking advantage of European Union opportunities before the establishment of the association. For example, 5 young people and 1 group leader who are members of our association participated in the Erasmus Youth Project named "Musica e Interculture" with the number 2019-1-IT03-KA105 015774. The participants organized various cultural and musical events in Geraci Sicilo, a charming town in the province of Palermo, Italy.

Volunteer Club

This group, consisting of young members of the youth center, organizes volunteering and aid activities as 2 different teams in many different areas in order to increase and spread the culture of volunteering.

From Social Media to Social Square

In this project carried out together with Kırıkkale Youth Center, in order to draw attention to social media and technology addiction and to ensure that young people actively take part in life by ensuring their participation in social and cultural activities, the events held in the largest square of the city include shows such as folk dances, theater, skits, concerts, painting, marbling, calligraphy and illumination arts, intelligence and mind games, model making, where they can develop and experience manual skills, as well as various artistic and cultural activities, as well as sports activities, street games and volunteering activities.

An Evening Without Television

Our families, who are the cornerstone of society, are made aware not only of technology addiction

but also of “substance, cigarette, alcohol and healthy living” issues in a comprehensive manner with the participation of experts in their fields. The family of the association member visited within the scope of the project is visited once a month in the evening hours by our project stakeholders, each of whom is an expert in their own fields, in a conversational atmosphere.

My Center is Everywhere

With the "My Center is Everywhere" project, in order to explain the activities and projects to the young people living in remote neighborhoods and to reach more young people by taking it beyond the boundaries of the place, traditional children's games in school gardens, educational games and courses held in youth centers are carried out by the young people in a practical way.
