

Eco.Log.Y. Invitation for partners

"Eco.Log.Y." – it's a multinational youth exchange project that will take place in Plateliai, Lithuania at the end of July this year. The project is organized by NGO "Krantas". NGO "Krantas" will apply for funding from EU programme "Youth in action" – action 1.1. "Youth exchanges". The deadline for the applications is the 1st of February.

Organization - NGO "Krantas" aims at creating a safe space for young people to realise their ideas, supports their initiatives and gives the opportunity on non-formal and intercultural learning. Organization is 11 years old and is one of the most active organizations in the region of Plunge, Lithuania. There are 25 active members in the organization. Previous experiences. During 11 years the members of the organization had organized 4 youth exchanges itself and have participated in more than 30 youth exchanges and conferences in Europe and Asia.

Current project – *Eco.Log.Y.*

Main topics of the project are: **ecology, sustainable consumption and social media**. 24 young people from 3 different countries will be involved in this project.

The project is supposed to last for 7 days, during which the participants of the project will learn and try to elaborate on the topics listed above: what are the problems regarding these topics in their home countries and how could these **people make an impact in their local communities**.

The methods that will be used in the exchange are **flashmobs**, **recycling and rebuilding workshops**, **working with video/photo media**, and other forms of **non-formal education** (energisers, simulation games and role play games).

One of the goals of the project is the **continuity of the activities and the results through social media**. There are only few social advertisements in Plunge – none of them are dedicated for ecology and sustainability. We have a goal of creating **attractive and creative social advertisements** (posters, leaflets, videos, etc.) that could be used in public places of Plunge and Plateliai.

Participants of the project will have a chance of bringing the outcomes of the project back to their home countries - this way spreading the word!



The project will be split into three stages:

Stage 1. Getting to know the problem

- The participants will have a chance to share their ideas and get to know ecological problems in Lithuania and their home countries;
- Participants get to know what methods can be used to make an impact to the society

Stage 2. Understanding the problem and looking for solutions

- Participants dig deeper into the problem and start using the methods:
 - Workshop on recycling and reusing takes place;
 - Getting ready for the local action takes place;

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Stage 3. Making an impact and working on solutions

- > Spending the day in Plunge town local action takes part (a flashmob, press conference, other activities that were planned in stage 2)
- A trip to one of the most beautiful national parks in Lithuania Kursiu nerija takes place.
- > The creation and presentation of the social advertisements takes place;

The aim of the activities is to make people of Plunge aware of the ecological issues in their areas and the situation in Europe. The project is aimed at the people of all ages in the area. Making an impact and a change in the thinking of the participants and the local community are the **main purposes of this project.**
