We provide education at all levels, from kindergarten to high school. Our Science and Anatolian High Schools employ 81 teachers and 10 administrative staff members. We currently have 380 students in the Anatolian High School and 178 students in the Science High School. Our institution has successfully participated in various European Union-funded international projects and has developed strong institutional capacity in project management, international cooperation, and dissemination activities.
