JEDEV is a youth association based in Yaoundé, Cameroon. Its work focuses on seven key areas:

- Ecology & sustainable agriculture (reforestation, recycling, gardens),
- Education & citizenship (literacy, civic values, digital innovation),
- Humanitarian & social action (support to vulnerable groups),
- Mobility & culture (exchanges, volunteering, sports & arts),
- Culture & interculturality (festivals, workshops, peace building),
- Socio-professional integration & entrepreneurship (green jobs, start-ups, training),
- Human rights, equality & inclusion (youth leadership, gender equality, tolerance).

What are the activities and experience of your organisation in the areas relevant for this application?

JEDEV develops its activities around seven main fields that are directly connected to the priorities of the Erasmus+ programme:

- **Ecology and sustainable agriculture:** organisation of reforestation campaigns and community clean-up actions, implementation of recycling and circular economy projects, awareness-raising on climate change, biodiversity and sustainable water management, as well as the promotion of agroecology through the creation of school and urban gardens.
- **Education, citizenship and digital innovation:** literacy and basic education programmes for disadvantaged youth and adults; workshops on civic values, peace, leadership and participatory democracy; training on digital tools, innovation and future-oriented professions; organisation of educational conferences, seminars and awareness campaigns.
- **Humanitarian and social action:** assistance to vulnerable populations (children, women, elderly people, refugees, internally displaced persons, and persons with disabilities); distribution of basic necessity kits during crises; community health, hygiene and nutrition awareness campaigns; implementation of solidarity micro-projects to foster community resilience and autonomy.
- **Mobility, culture and exchanges:** participation in and organisation of cultural, artistic and sports exchanges in Cameroon and abroad; study trips, solidarity camps and international mobility projects (including Erasmus+), promoting intercultural dialogue, non-formal education and cooperation among peoples.
- **Culture and interculturality:** promotion of arts, culture and sports as tools for education and social integration; organisation of cultural and artistic events, festivals and workshops that foster peace, intercultural dialogue and social cohesion.
- **Socio-professional integration and entrepreneurship:** support for young people in the creation of small businesses, cooperatives and start-ups; promotion of green and social entrepreneurship; professional training adapted to labour market needs in order to reduce youth unemployment.
- **Human rights, equality, peace and social inclusion:** promotion of human rights and social justice; awareness-raising actions on gender equality, tolerance and peace; inclusion of marginalised, out-of-school or disabled youth; workshops on active citizenship, participatory democracy and youth leadership.

Through these activities, **JEDEV** has gained solid experience in youth mobilisation, civic and environmental awareness, social inclusion, and community cooperation. The association is eager to strengthen these achievements through European partnerships and to contribute actively to Erasmus+ projects by bringing motivated young people, innovative ideas and grassroots practices.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons in your organisation that will be involved in this project?

JEDEV relies on a young, motivated and multidisciplinary team with diverse and complementary skills that will be directly mobilised within the framework of this Erasmus+ project.

- **Youth facilitation and mobilisation:** experience in conducting participatory workshops and awareness campaigns on citizenship, health and ecology, linked to the axes Education & Active Citizenship and Culture & Interculturality.
- **Expertise in ecology and sustainable development:** knowledge and practice in reforestation campaigns, recycling, agroecology and climate change awareness, covering the axis Ecology & Sustainable Development.
- **Humanitarian and social competences:** volunteers trained in distributing emergency aid, organising health and nutrition prevention campaigns, and supporting vulnerable populations, related to the axis Solidarity & Humanitarian Action.
- **Education and digital skills:** members trained in IT, office software, graphic design and digital tools, able to develop educational resources and support young people in digital learning, strengthening the axis Education & Active Citizenship.
- **Leadership and project management:** the leadership team has expertise in planning, coordinating and monitoring projects, building partnerships and managing volunteers, which is essential for the axis International Mobility & Volunteering.
- **Socio-professional integration and entrepreneurship:** expertise in supporting young people to create small businesses, cooperatives and green or social projects, in line with the axis Socio-professional Integration & Entrepreneurship.
- **Human rights and social inclusion:** awareness and advocacy for human rights, gender equality, peace and tolerance; inclusion of marginalised, out-of-school or disabled youth; promotion of youth civic leadership, related to the axis Human Rights, Equality, Peace & Social Inclusion.
