An overview of the Al-Mashal Association for Culture, Development and Sports is a non-profit Moroccan organization established in **2023** and based in **Bouarfa**, **Morocco**. The association works to empower young people through cultural, sports, and volunteering activities, with a particular focus on youth from marginalized areas.

#### Mission:

Al-Mashal Association for Culture, Development and Sports is committed to promoting social inclusion, active citizenship, intercultural dialogue, and sustainable community development. The organization believes that culture, sports, and volunteering are powerful tools for positive social change and for fostering responsible and engaged young citizens.

### **Activities:**

The association organizes a wide range of activities and initiatives, including:

- Annual football tournaments for marginalized youth, especially the Ramadan Football **League**, followed by a closing ceremony to honor the winners.
- Solidarity initiatives providing symbolic support to families of young people from the local community during humanitarian occasions.
- Active contribution to humanitarian response during the Al Haouz earthquake through fundraising, collecting food supplies and blankets, and distributing them directly to affected populations.
- Cleaning and maintenance campaigns of Islamic, Jewish, and Christian cemeteries, including wall painting and tree planting activities.
- Collection and distribution of clothes and blankets to people in need from the local community.
- Organization of a monthly free haircut day for people living in marginalized areas.
- Annual environmental days dedicated to tree and plant planting.
- Organization of educational and recreational camps for children.
- Awareness-raising seminars and meetings focusing on women's and children's issues.

### Impact:

Al-Mashal Association has had a positive impact on the local community by supporting vulnerable groups, strengthening the spirit of solidarity and volunteerism, empowering youth, and contributing to environmental protection and humanitarian action.

### Future:

The association remains committed to expanding its activities, strengthening national and international partnerships, and developing new programs for youth and children, aiming to build a more inclusive, resilient, and sustainable community.

# Humanitarian Response to the Al Haouz Earthquake 2023

The first field activity of *Al-Mashal Association for Culture, Development and Sports* was linked to one of the most significant natural disasters experienced by Morocco, the Al Haouz earthquake. Despite the fact that the affected area is located approximately 800 kilometers away from the association's headquarters, the members of the association mobilized with a strong sense of national responsibility and human solidarity to support the affected communities and stand alongside their fellow citizens during this difficult time.

The association organized a local solidarity campaign that involved collecting in-kind donations from the residents of Bouarfa, including food supplies, clothing, and blankets. The initiative went beyond simply sending aid; with the support of the Bouarfa Municipality, the association's members personally traveled to the Al Haouz region to directly supervise the distribution process and ensure that assistance reached the affected families in a dignified and effective manner.

This initiative represented a pivotal milestone in the history of the association, as it strengthened the spirit of volunteerism and solidarity among its members and provided them with valuable humanitarian and field experience. It also reaffirmed the association's commitment to the values of active citizenship, volunteer engagement, and responsible intervention during times of crisis.
