2. Legal Status & Institutional Eligibility

USHAF Nigeria is a legally registered, non-profit civil society organisation established in 2011 and operating continuously in Nigeria. The organisation pursues a public-interest mandate and does not distribute profits to members or founders.

As an organisation legally established in Sub-Saharan Africa, USHAF Nigeria is fully eligible to participate as a Partner Country organisation under Erasmus+ Capacity Building actions in the field of Youth (CBY), in accordance with programme rules.

3. Mission & Strategic Focus

Vision

A Nigeria where young people and communities actively participate in democratic life, prevent civic risks, and sustain peace.

Mission

To strengthen youth-led civic engagement, democratic participation, and community accountability through early warning systems, truth clarification, and non-formal civic education.

Strategic Focus

USHAF Nigeria operates as a civic engagement and democratic resilience organisation. Its work focuses on:

- Youth civic engagement and participation
- Democratic resilience and peacebuilding
- Countering misinformation and civic risk prevention
- Non-formal civic education and youth leadership development

This strategic orientation aligns directly with Erasmus+ Capacity Building priorities related to youth participation, inclusion, civic competence, and institutional strengthening.

4. Organisational Structure & Human Resources

USHAF Nigeria operates through an integrated civic infrastructure framework referred to as the Civic Immune System, composed of three complementary pillars:

- Olóbo Alert Network: Community-based early warning and civic risk detection
- Amòyẹ Explainer Hub: Truth clarification, civic education, and counter-misinformation activities
- Àjùmòṣe Community Compact: Community accountability, dialogue, and peace mechanisms

Human Resource Capacity

- 7 core staff responsible for coordination, programme management, and administration
- Over 100 trained volunteers mobilised annually
- 10 community focal persons across operational states
- Technical advisory support in monitoring & evaluation and capacity building

This structure enables scalable implementation, local ownership, and effective delivery of Erasmus+ activities at community level.

5. Relevant Experience & Track Record

USHAF Nigeria has demonstrated implementation experience directly relevant to Erasmus+ Capacity Building objectives, including:

- SafeCity Nigeria (2023): Community-based digital reporting and prevention of gender-based violence, strengthening youth participation and civic accountability.
- Project HEARTS: School-based safeguarding and youth well-being initiative using anonymous reporting and early intervention mechanisms.
- Project CLEAR: Civic and environmental early warning initiative integrating misinformation prevention during emergencies.
- Ìjọba Awá Àrà Wá (2026): Youth-led democratic resilience programme piloting civic engagement systems across ten Local Government Areas in Osun State.

These initiatives demonstrate practical implementation capacity, youth engagement expertise, and experience working with multi-stakeholder and community-based approaches.
