## DIGITAL LITERACY

The rationale for implementing this project, which encompasses skills in critical media literacy and safe digital engagement, is to cultivate digital awareness among youth workers actively engaged in the field across Europe and Turkey, to foster consciousness regarding digital risks, and to equip them with practical, applicable skills in this domain.

## RAISING AWARENESS

It seeks to equip participants with a nuanced understanding of digital literacy by grounding the subject not only in theory but in real-world applications connected to their daily lives.

## COLLECTIVE EMPOWERMENT

By leveraging envisaged collaborations that synthesize academic knowledge, an engineering perspective, and field experience, the project aims to make a long-term contribution to empowering disadvantaged youth to participate as informed, secure, and active individuals in the digital world.



# PROJECT ROADMAP

## ARRIVAL & MEET

Participants will arrive at the accommodation and settle in. Following a rest period, ice-breaking activities will facilitate introductions and provide a general project overview.

## WORKSHOP

The program will advance through diverse, hands-on workshops designed to deepen participants' understanding.

## APPLICATIONS

Relevant to the project's scope, a series of hands-on practices and diverse activities will be carried out.

## ISTANBUL TRIP

As part of our project, we will visit historical and tourist sites in Istanbul with our participants and experience the city's unique cultural delights.
