It has two goals:

1

- It's a Youth-led project, created **by youth for youth**
- The content, the activities and the program is established by youngsters, **they own the process**
- The team will consist of youngsters who **have never before organized a YE**
- **JOETZ is there to guide and coach them from A to Z**

- It aims to provide **a space for collective artistic collaboration** for the participants
- During this week they will have the possibility to **work on their possessed skills or explore new** ways of self- & cultural expression
- At the final days, **a collective exhibition/concert** will be **self-organized** in Antwerp

We are targeting youngsters who:

- Are **between 18 and 30** with a creative mind
- Have some experience in youth work, but not so much with Erasmus+
- **Have a drive to express themselves artistically** and who are motivated to develop a little project within their own community
- Have **some experience with the cultural field** and are motivated to explore and immerse themselves
- Maintain an **open attitude toward all participants**
- Are prepared for **a week full of creation, collaboration and collective learning** in an urban setting
- Important to note: participants do not need to be artists!








