Who are we ?

The **Big Bang Ballers** is a 16 years old association based in Grenoble, France. We see **sports as a vehicle for social inclusion and education**. However, the traditional way it is organized is reflecting or even increasing social inequalities. So our main goal is to **strengthen social cohesion by making sport and its benefits more inclusive and accessible to those who are traditionally excluded from it: young and elderly people, women, but also people with disabilities, having socio-economic difficulties, or living in areas often isolated from sports practice (suburbs).**

We try to gather sport, education and social actors, through networking, formation and exchange of good practices. This is why we created the **“Welcom’In clubs”** project, to make sport structures and actors more inclusive. For example, we developed alternative rules to traditional sport games, in order to make different people with heterogenous levels play together.

Specific goals

Building on the experience of a previous Erasmus+ small scale Youth partnership, we are willing to go further with this one.

The specific goals are :

- fighting socio-economic discriminations and stereotypes
- fostering social cohesion by provoking intercultural exchanges
- sensitizing the traditional sports communities and the general public to inclusive sports
