Please briefly present the partner organization.	Ascend Futures is a youth-focused non-governmental organisation based in Ukraine and working across Europe. The organisation supports young people in accessing international education, volunteering, and mobility opportunities through European programmes such as Erasmus+ and the European Solidarity Corps. Ascend Futures works as a sending and support organisation, helping young people prepare for and participate in youth exchanges, training courses, ESC volunteering, workcamps, and study-abroad pathways. The organisation is committed to promoting youth empowerment, intercultural dialogue, inclusion, and active citizenship, especially among young people from Ukraine and other underrepresented backgrounds. Through international partnerships and digital outreach, Ascend Futures connects young people with high-quality learning experiences that help them develop skills, confidence, and a European outlook.
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What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?	Ascend Futures is actively involved in promoting and supporting international youth mobility through Erasmus+ and the European Solidarity Corps. The organisation works as a sending and support organisation, guiding young people through the entire participation process — from discovering opportunities and applying, to preparation, mentoring, and follow-up after their return. Our activities include: ● Recruiting and selecting young people for Erasmus+ Youth Exchanges, Training Courses, and ESC volunteering projects ● Providing pre-departure preparation, intercultural training, and practical guidance ● Supporting participants during their projects and ensuring quality learning outcomes ● Promoting Erasmus+ and ESC opportunities through digital platforms, social media, and online information sessions ● Disseminating project results and sharing participants' experiences to inspire other young people Although Ascend Futures is a young organisation, the team has experience working with international partners, supporting dozens of participants in EU-funded
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	mobility projects, and building a growing European partner network. This enables the organisation to ensure high-quality participation, strong communication with host organisations, and meaningful learning experiences for young people.

The key staff and team members of Ascend Futures have strong experience in international youth mobility, project coordination, and youth support. Ascend Futures works with a motivated and diverse group of young people from Ukraine and across Europe who are actively involved in the preparation and implementation of its activities. They include students, recent graduates, volunteers, and young professionals who are interested in international learning, social impact, and intercultural cooperation. Many of them have previous experience in Erasmus+, ESC, youth exchanges, and international volunteering, and they contribute their knowledge by supporting outreach, peer mentoring, promotion of opportunities, and participant preparation. Young people are also involved in content creation, dissemination of project results, and supporting new applicants, ensuring that the organisation remains youth-led, inclusive, and closely connected to the needs of its community.
