Project Title DIGIWORK- Building Partnerships for Digital and Hybrid Youth Work| Erasmus+ KA153-YOU, Mobility of Youth Workers

Applicant Organisation Consortium formation coordinated by Pacem International Youth Association (partner, Istanbul).

Duration of Mobility 8 days (6 activity days + 2 travel days), preceded by a 2-day Advance Planning Visit

Number of Participants 2 youth workers per partner organisation (APV: 1 per partner). Target consortium: 8-9 organisations.

Project Summary

DIGIWORK is a partnership-building activity under Erasmus+ KA153-YOU. It brings together grassroots youth organisations with limited or no international project experience to build a lasting cooperation network in digital and hybrid youth work. Through one Advance Planning Visit and one 8-day seminar, participating youth workers will develop competences in hybrid activity design, e-participation tools and digital outreach, using structured online debate as a working method. The partnership network established during the project is expected to produce joint follow-up applications within 24 months. The application will be submitted at the 1 October 2026 deadline for implementation between January and December 2027.

What We Seek

1. Non-profit organisations active in youth work, holding a valid OID number.
2. Grassroots profile welcome: limited or no previous Erasmus+ experience is not a barrier. It is the target profile of this project.
3. Demonstrated local youth work and a concrete interest in digital or hybrid methods.
4. Capacity to select and prepare 2 youth workers through a transparent, criteria-based procedure.
5. Commitment to the APV, the full mobility, national dissemination and joint follow-up applications.

1. Send a motivation text of two paragraphs: (1) the digital youth work gap in your country, supported by concrete observations; (2) your organisation's local work and why you need international partnership.
2. Attach your OID number and a one-paragraph organisational profile.
3. Deadline for expressions of interest: 01.08.2026.
