Circle for Training and Consultancy is a long-standing partner of the British Council in Egypt, collaborating on youth empowerment, leadership, inclusion, and community development programmes.

Egyptian Youth Thriving 2026-2025

Circle implemented the Egyptian Youth Thriving (EYT) programme in partnership with the British Council, empowering young people to become active community change-makers. The programme strengthens youth leadership and advocacy capacities and supports youth-led, sustainable community initiatives while promoting inclusion, civic engagement, and long-term social impact.

Inclusive Youth Empowerment Program 2025-2024

A youth empowerment programme implemented in partnership with the British Council, supporting young people, including persons with disabilities, with strategic skills to create positive impact in their communities. The programme emphasizes sustainable cooperation between governmental and non-governmental institutions to enhance youth participation.

Active Citizens 2024-2023

Circle contributed to the implementation of Active Citizens, a training programme focused on social leadership, intercultural dialogue, and community-led social development. The programme targeted communities in Beheira Governorate and Alexandria and resulted in six social action projects addressing local challenges and promoting positive community change.

Young Mediterranean Voices

Circle contributed to the implementation of Young Mediterranean Voices, a regional debate programme implemented by the British Council across eight countries in the Southern Mediterranean region. In Egypt, the programme was delivered through partnerships with universities, the Ministry of Youth and Sports, and training organizations including Circle for Training and Consultancy.

KÜLTÜR KERVANI

As a partner organization under Grant Agreement No. 2019-2-TR01-KA105-078220, Circle Training and Consulting collaborated with organizations from Bulgaria, Azerbaijan, Jordan, Lithuania, Spain, and Turkey for the "KÜLTÜR KERVANI" project. The project, which was held in March 2020, aimed to promote cultural exchange and understanding among young people. Activities included workshops, cultural events, and collaborative projects, with approximately 60 participants from all participating countries.



Livelihood Project

Circle successfully contributed to the implementation of a livelihood program aimed at economically empowering vulnerable communities and refugees. Organized and managed a bazaar that provided beneficiaries with a platform to showcase and market their products, supporting income generation and entrepreneurship.

Acted as a key partner in coordinating the closing ceremony of the project, hosted at Jesuit Cultural Center.

Delivered a comprehensive closing event that included cultural performances and artistic showcases, highlighting diversity and fostering social inclusion.

Collaborated closely with partners and stakeholders to ensure high-quality implementation and impactful community engagement.



Design of a guide for service providers for refugees and seekers and migrants

Within the framework of the project to enhance the quality of protection and education for migrant and refugee children in Alexandria Governorate, which aims to improve services provided to refugees, asylum seekers, and migrants in Alexandria Governorate by increasing access to child protection and education services and improving levels of community cohesion, the project seeks to produce a services directory that includes all governmental and non-governmental places, institutions, and facilities that serve the refugee community in the project implementation areas.
