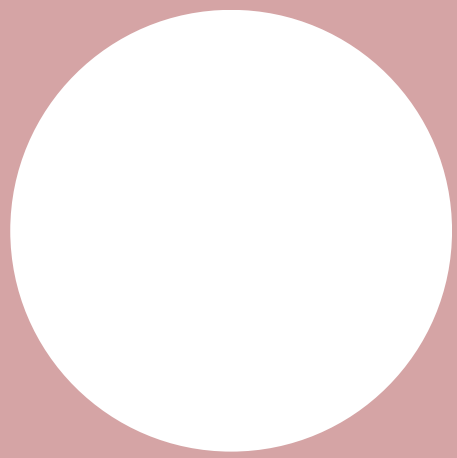

# About the Project

Learning Through Dramatic Situations is an Erasmus+ Youth Workers Mobility project. It is a nine-day training course built around one question: what makes a dramatic situation worth doing?

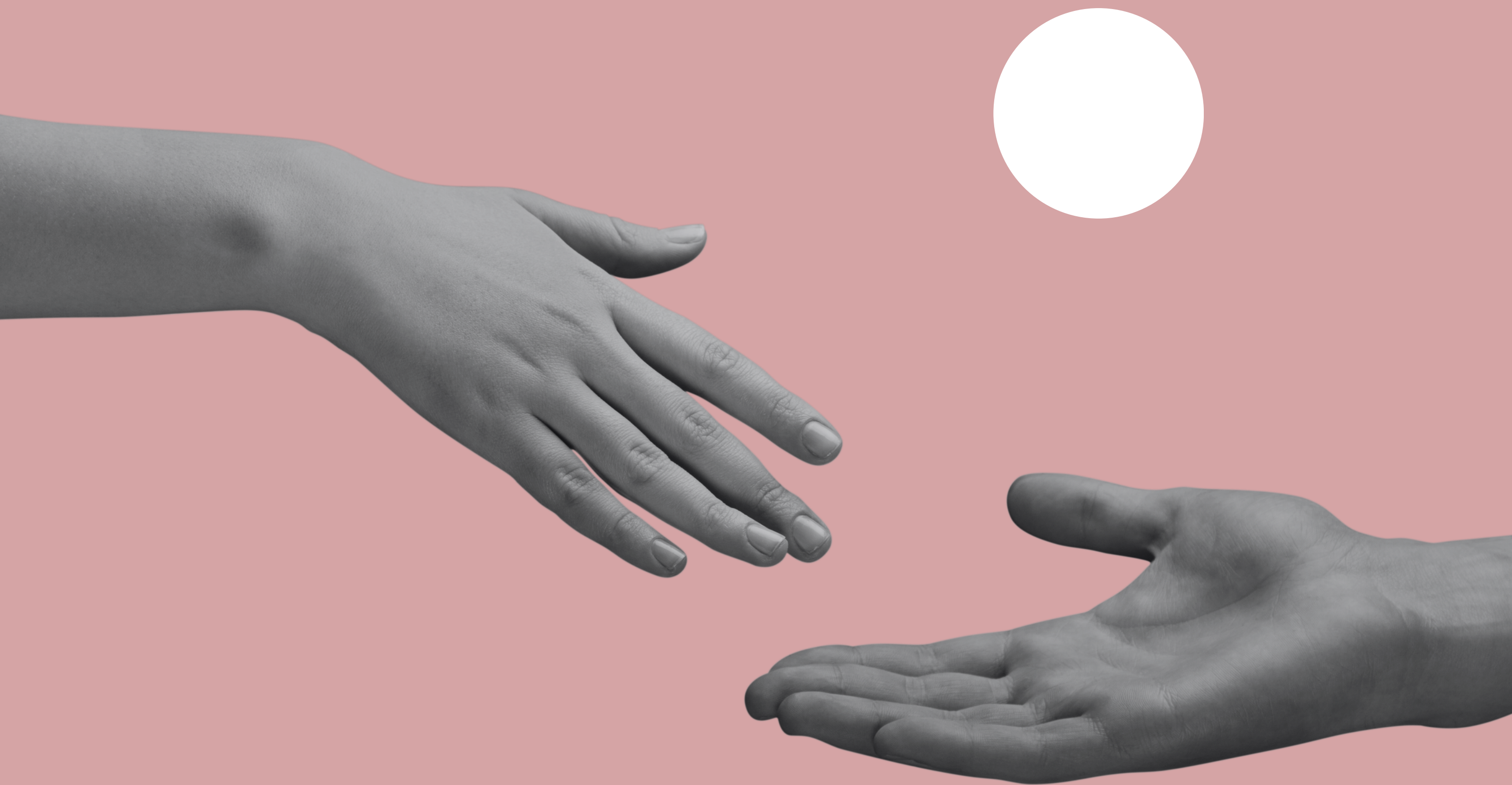
Youth workers explore how structured drama gives young people a safe place to try out dialogue, decisions and other points of view, and how a clear learning aim and a real reflection turn the experience into learning. Participants experience the methods, take them apart, and design and test sessions of their own.





# Project Objectives

- design a short learning session around a dramatic situation with a clear learning aim
- facilitate it and adapt it to the group in the moment
- lead reflection that connects experience with learning
- create a safe and inclusive space for participation
- transfer the method into your own practice and your organisation
- build lasting cooperation between organisations working with creative methods



# Participant Profile

We are looking for:

- youth workers, group leaders, facilitators
- with interest in theatre arts, drama or creative methods
- motivated to use drama for learning
- aged 18+
- able to work in English at a conversational level
- committed to full participation in all sessions

We expect organisations to send 5 participants. Formal school teachers are not the target group.



# Host Organisation

## Dramacentrum Bezejména

Bezejména Drama Centre is a non-formal education and theatre organisation from Liberec, Czech Republic. We work with drama and theatre arts as tools for learning, reflection and creative expression.

We run several children's and youth theatre groups, organise the international youth festival JeštěDyvadlo and deliver drama-based educational programmes in schools and community settings. Our work focuses on creativity, cooperation, communication and exploring real-life themes through structured dramatic situations.

Our team consists of theatre practitioners and drama educators experienced in working with international groups and designing meaningful learning processes in youth work. We enjoy connecting with partners from different countries and creating spaces where people can learn, experiment and reflect together.



# Programme Overview

The programme is an intensive non-formal learning experience built on drama and experiential learning. Every day has a focus, one method to try, guided reflection and a step towards transfer into your own work.

The first days build trust and a shared language. The middle days take methods apart and practise facilitation. In the last days, small international groups design, test and reflect on a short session based on a dramatic situation, focusing on learning aims, group dynamics and transfer into youth work practice. Everyone experiences the full cycle as both participant and facilitator. Before the course, you complete a short self-assessment based on the ETS Competence Model for Youth Workers to Work Internationally, and you repeat it at the end. You leave with a personal toolkit and a Youthpass certificate. Three months later, a short questionnaire helps you look back at what you have used. Selected sessions are published in the open collection LTDS Practice Notes.



# Venue & Accommodation

Location: Liberec, Czech Republic

Dates: 4th-12th September 2026

Accommodation will be provided in shared rooms.

Training sessions will take place in a theatre/creative spaces in Liberec suitable for drama work (exact venues to be confirmed).

Meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner + coffee breaks) will be provided. Food will be vegetarian.



# Financial Conditions

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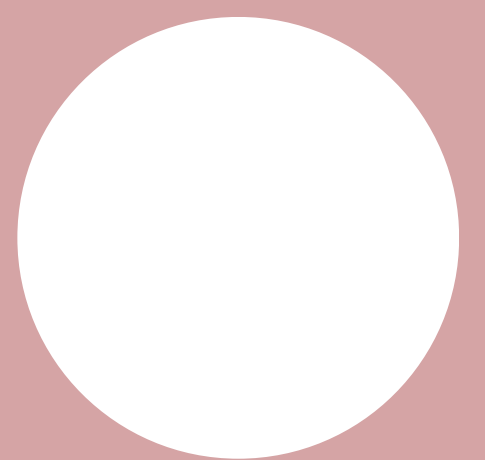
