

EOIs: Public Language Schools

- A network of 12 public schools (with approximately 30 delegate sections in secondary schools) depending on the Galician Autonomous Government
- Specialized in Language-Learning and teaching

EOIs: Public Language Schools

- Teaching foreign languages (mostly) to adults.
- Promoting multilingual skills as a way of enhancing European cohesion and new opportunities for mobility and employability.

EOIs: Public Language Schools

- Entry requirements:
 - Anyone 16 or over
 - Special admission for students 14 or over who have the same foreign language in secondary school.


