About the Project

“Increasing Youth Employment Opportunities” is training course designed to strengthen the competences of youth workers for combating unemployment. Participants in this TC by active and practical methods will be dynamically engaged in the learning process, where they will have the opportunity to enhance skills and gain the competences necessary to guide and develop activities for increasing the employment competences among the young people with fewer opportunities in their community.

Objectives:

- To learn how to recognize values and interests, assessing attributes and skills, identifying learning styles and learning strategies, goal setting, planning and tracking progress
- To transfer knowledge for identifying and practicing workplace behaviors most often required by local employers.
- Empower young people to work in team, learn from each other, giving and receiving feedback
- To learn about the local labor markets, educate how to write an effective CV, prepare a clear letter of application, interviewing skills and job search basics
- To lead and educate young people in budgeting, savings, planning skills that can help young people manage their income and expenses.
- To learn for the new programme that will follow after the YiA Programme and promote it among young people, providing mobility and volunteering opportunities for young people where they can develop their competences.
