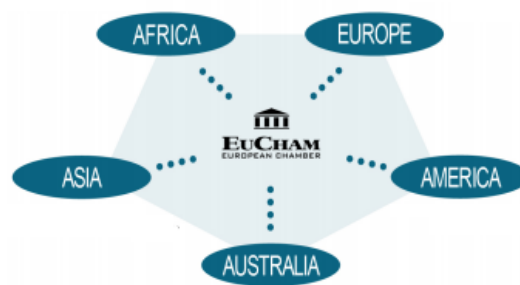




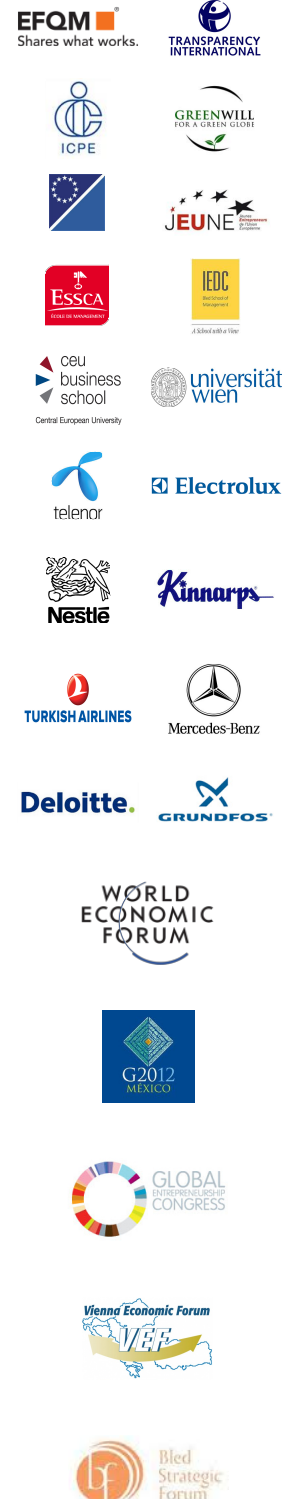
The mission of EuCham is to represent and promote the interest of national and international companies doing business in Europe, improving the business environment they are active in.
