Duration of the activities: 7 days + 2 travel days

National groups: 7

Composition of national group: 5 participants (18-25) + 1 leader (no age limit).

Total number: around 35 participants and 7 leaders.

Themes:

Human rights, social inclusion, intercultural learning.

Aim:

Active involvement of participants in the preparation, organization and implementation of activities in each local community after the youth exchange related with human rights, social inclusion and intercultural learning. This project wants to discuss this important topic according to European Union's aims. We want to create a blog continuously updated by participants reporting discriminations and violations of human rights in their societies and how to implement actions to protect human rights.

Objectives:

- 1) Promoting social inclusion of young people with less opportunities;
- 2) Raising awareness about the importance of human rights in everyday life;

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- 3) Promoting values such gender balance, stop violence, respect each other, refugees, Roma people and LGBT discrimination;
- 4) Promoting human rights through non formal education activities, workshops, discussions and brainstorming;
- 5) Stopping discriminations;
- 6) Promoting intercultural learning and overcoming stereotypes.

Group preparation and participation involvement

For the involvement of the participants before and during the project each group will prepare:

- 1) a short research and presentation about discrimination and violations of human rights in their own countries;
- 2) the International Night: presenting their country with typical food.

Speaking English in a fluent way is not important: a basic knowledge of English is enough.

Money:

The project covers 100% of food and accommodation and 70% of the travel costs, and for those who need 100% of Visa costs.

This youth exchange will take place in Italy.
