- Develop follow up activities

Through non-formal learning methods and tools (peer education, group discussions, presentations, interactive exercises, sharing for experiences and know-how etc), this seminar aspires to facilitate the exchange of knowledge, ideas and experiences, and to enable the creation of a new partnership platform, for networking in the future.

**Living Expenses:** All the living expenses (accommodation, meals, material, etc.) will be fully covered by the hosting organization.

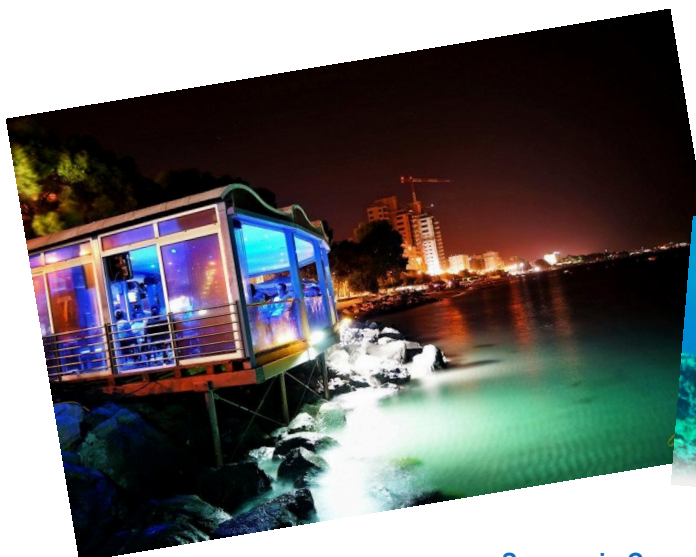
**Travel Expenses:** Ticket reimbursement depends from the distance of your country to Cyprus. The MAX amount is shown at the following table:

3000 - 3999km	530 euro
4000 - 7999km	820 euro
