Project Summary:

The international exchange "We prevent violence - we build equality: diversity, human rights and participation, the response of young to violence", aims the creation of a space of encounter in which is fostered reflection, well as the personal commitment and collective, around the promotion and protection of human rights and the prevention of all forms of violence of human dignity, social exclusion, violence, racism, intolerance and discrimination., starting from the realization that teens should and can exert a fundamental role as protagonists in preventing violence in their environment.

To do this it comes to understand the nature of violence, try to establish a concept of violence, recognizing that this is can produce in all social contexts, including relations between young; which are the conditions that increase your risk or protect of she , as begins, as evolves and the damage that produces to young people who with her coexist, well as the special situation of vulnerability in which are found certain collectives of young. All with the purpose of favoring a general representation of the violence that help combat it. Analyze, specifically, urban violence and violence in school, violence linked to intolerance and discrimination, gender violence.

The objectives of this project are:

- Develop strategies violence prevention starting from recognizing of young as potential actors, increasing its sense of responsibility and promoting their participation and cooperation in this topic.

- Analyze the concepts of human dignity, social cohesion and democratic citizenship related with violence prevention concerning juveniles.
- Include in youth associations and youth groups performances that promote the dialogue intercultural as key factor to prevent violence motivated by racism and xenophobia.
- Include in the performances of youth associations and youth groups the priority of gender, sexuality and power, in order to prevent gender violence, violence homo phobic and any another performance violent than harming young people by grounds of sex.
- Promote from youth associations and youth groups prevention networks violence youth for youth in which the actions developed are based in education no formal and training, and in this context is valued especially the promotion for active citizenship and participation.

It is intended disclose and publicize program objectives Youth, to frame this encounter within the same especially in what refers to the involvement of participants in projects that develop the objectives and conclusions of this exchange, especially those that promote initiatives implemented by young and for youth and that have as fundamental objectives the prevention of violence and propitiate their inclusion as active citizens in their communities of origin.

Conditions: Accommodation, board and programmed costs will be Financed European Commission through Erasmus+. Travel costs will be reimbursed to the participating organization under the terms of + Erasmus program and according to the project approved by the Spanish National Agency.

Working language: Ingles and Spanish.

IMPORTANT REMARKS

Participating organizations should buy the flights according to the provisions of the Erasmus program +. Travel costs will be reimbursed once the project is completed and we have received the payment of the grant by the Spanish National Agency. We can not advance before travel costs. On many occasions the National Agency may take several months to transfer the settlement of the grant.

International travel is considered from the point of origin of the participating organization to the city where the project takes place.

The participating organization will collaborate and participate actively before, during and after the project. It is important that the organization has a person who can speak Spanish for this project.

Participating organizations will have to pay for liability insurance, lost documents, flights and medical coverage for each project participant.

Participating organizations must demonstrate work experience in mobility projects and accredit economic solvency to pay, insurance, international travel etc...

The application form for the project will be developed with input from all participating organizations.

With all applications provided this association will perform a selection process of participating organizations.
