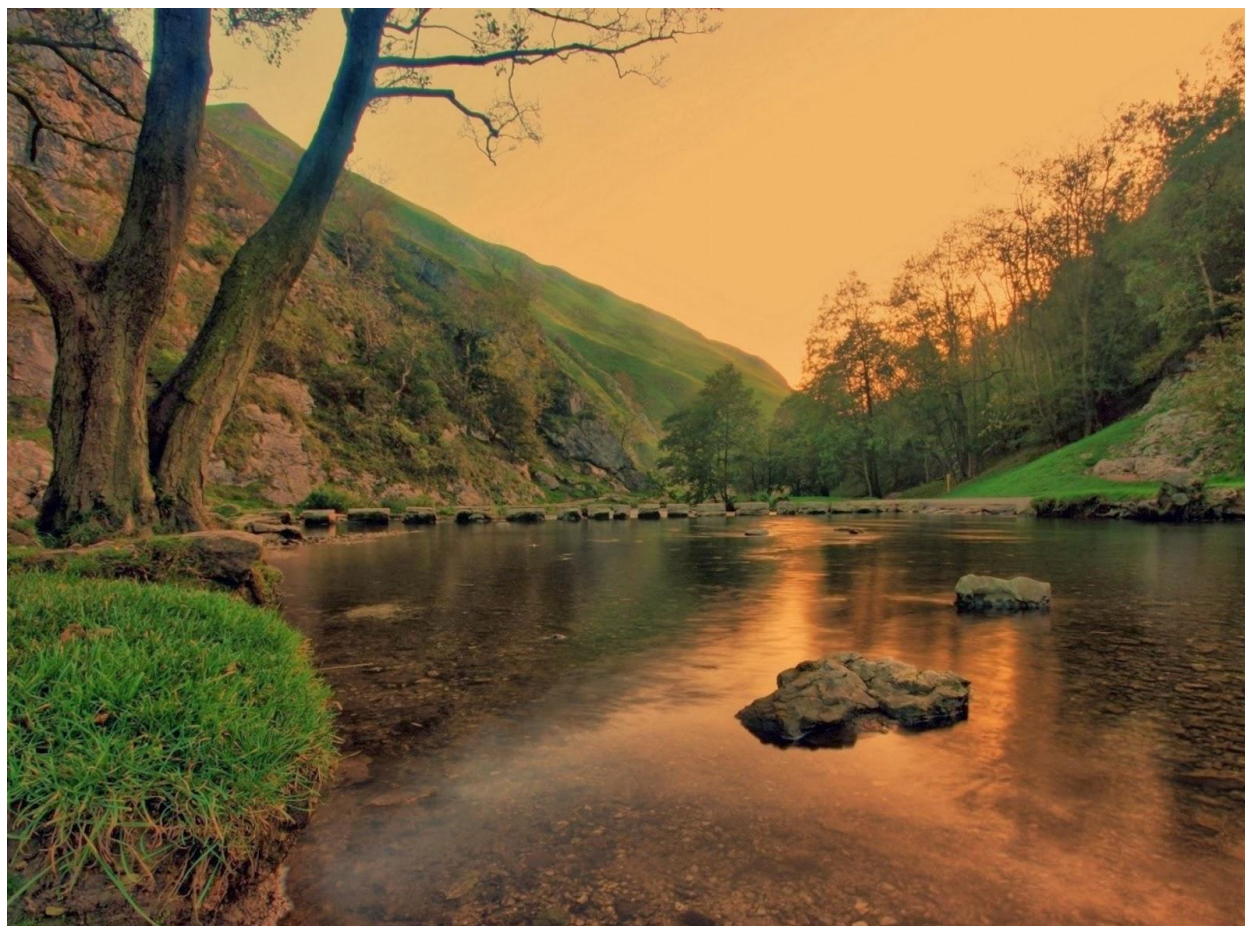
Getting along with the nature

international training course for youth leaders/multipliers

who will be facilitating projects with kids and youth groups (13-18) activities on the topic of

climate protection

Nuremberg (Nürnberg, Germany), 2-8 November 2015

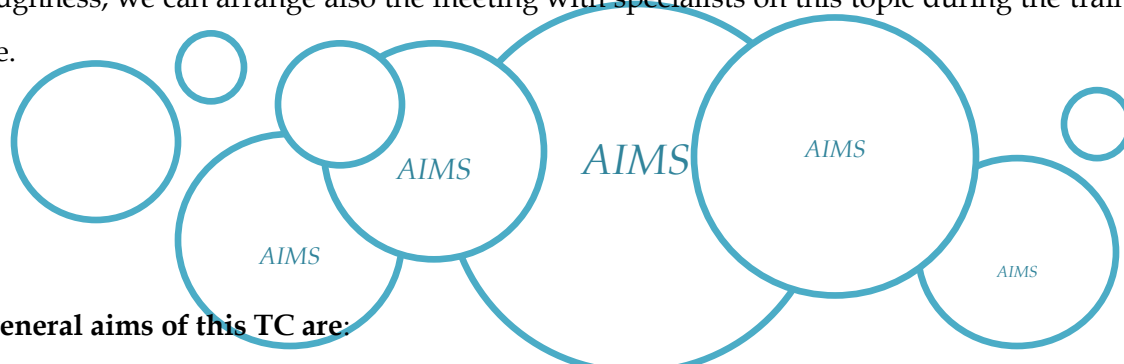


This Training Course will prepare youth leaders and multipliers of youth exchanges dealing with teenagers 13-18 to run international activities on mentioned topic. They will not only learn basics of **project management, leadership skills, group processes, and methodology of non-formal education**, but also learn more on the topic of climate protection itself.

They will get to know for example:

- how to buy and prepare food protecting the climate,
- how to organize free-time activities protecting the climate (reducing CO2-output),
- how to be mobile (means of transport) protecting the climate,
- how an accommodation should protect the climate...

Training will lead professional climate pedagogues and will refer to scientific evidences and reliable sources, as well as trusted methods of climate-protection. In order to preserve thoroughness, we can arrange also the meeting with specialists on this topic during the training course.



The general aims of this TC are:

- to initiate the wider discussion on climate-protection with young generation of Europeans in order to raise awareness on different simple ways of reducing negative impact of human activities on the nature
- to promote healthy lifestyle by giving clear hints for "harmless living" to teenagers and through extension - their parents
- to boost creativity, sense of entrepreneurship and innovation in the topic of climate protection among young people around Europe

After this Training Course we plan to organize a *set of youth exchanges for teenagers 13-18 all around Europe (with our partners) on the topic of climate-protection in our daily life.*

Thereby we will not only disseminate and multiply effects of this TC, but also **initiate a social change (change of awareness) on European level among young generation of Europeans**. This set of exchanges will be a part of online campaign indicating practical advices on different ways of reducing negative impact on the nature in our daily lives, during casual activities. Our target age group is 13-18, therefore campaign will be directed to schools and youth centers in our partner`s countries mostly.

Training Course methodology and activities

Activities will be organized along non-formal education methodology, including tools like: simulations, workshops, creative-sessions, brainstorming, or group tasks.

They will include for example:

- 1) presentation of European Union regulations on the topic of climate-protection and stadium of their implementation in national legislations of EU member states in order to understand the value of the problem and motivate to undertake concrete bottom-top actions,
- 2) developing youth-friendly language describing environmental issues and strategies of attracting attention of this specific age group,
- 3) developing ideas for future youth exchanges along ground-rules of project management (designing methodologically correct projects),
- 4) developing and testing tools for future youth exchanges – simulations, games or group tasks aiming at understanding the essence of touched problems and collective responsibility of all people for protecting the climate on a daily basis.

Competences to be developed by participants of TC:

- project management, leadership and team management skills – we will not only give theoretical input on it, but also test some invented tools and thereby train leadership and team management skills,
- adjustment of tools to specific age group of youngsters 13-18 – creativity, flexibility, communication skills,

- abilities to observe and recognize phases of group development and facilitate the transfer from beginning phases into performing phase,
- knowledge on EU regulations on climate protection and diversity of approaches towards them in different European countries,

Costs and conditions
