



CreativITY and recycling – M.A.S.K.

Youth mobility, 16.07.2015 – 26.07.2015, 10 activity days

Main aim: raising awareness and highlighting the importance of “United in diversity”, active European citizenship and recognition of non-formal learning process

Objectives:

- Improve basic and transverse skills and competencies (entrepreneurship, multilingualism and TIC) of youth through participation in workshop masks of waste / recyclable material and editing the masks manufacture manual;
- Acquiring knowledge and skills in the delivery masks (papier-mâché technique skill, chromatic skill etc);
- The promotion and awareness of the principles of equity and social inclusion through the participation in the project of young people unemployed and young people from disadvantaged backgrounds;
- Empowering young people and their ability to be active in society by organizing a masquerade in “Save the children – Targoviste Day Centers” benefit;
- Improving intercultural dialogue and solidarity of young people by spending time together with persons who share the same concerns;
- Improving communication and teamwork skills;
- Developing a positive attitude towards the environment, the learning experiences and from conflicts;
- To familiarize participants with the concept of Youth Pass, as a result of the process of non-formal education;
- Reflect on their learning experiences and exploring methods of self-learning and self-assessment ;
- Strengthen cooperation between youth organizations and between them and local authorities / SMEs and other organizations;

Who Should Attend :

The project targets are young people who have to fulfill the following conditions:

- Age: between 15 and 30 years;
- Ability to communicate in English (beginner level) and participate in activities throughout its;
- Group of young people will be at least four (two girls, two boys) + 1 leader and up to 8 (4 girls, 4 boys) + 2 leaders / each participating organization
- Countries: EU Member States, EFTA / EEA countries (Iceland, Norway and Lichtenstein), Turkey, the Western Balkans (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, FYR Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia) and Switzerland.

Preparation:

- Each organization should prepare a max. 10 minutes presentation of the country and the organization (preferably on flipchart no power-point);
- Bring food and drinks to their traditional cultural evening;

Conditions:

- Meals and accommodation are provided by the host organization;
- There is no participation fee ;
- Transportation: Erasmus + foresees a forfeit for travel costs; participants must buy the cheapest plane / train / bus / ferry tickets (taxis and cars are not reimbursed). Participants must keep all travel documents; the reimbursed will be based solely on original documents, on bank transfer during activity or after you return home and send us the original documents.
