



Talking, Cooking and Given away

Youth mobility, 01.07.2015 – 10.07.2015, 10 activity days

Main aim: raising, highlighting and awareness of active citizenship and recognition of non-formal learning process

Objectives:

- Acquiring new knowledge on European citizenship and awareness of the importance of individual and group intervention to young people in the community life;
- Improve basic and transverse skills and competencies (entrepreneurship, multilingualism and literacy) of youth through participation in the workshop “The Biscuit messenger” – a thematic customization (hand-made) and packing biscuits;
- Acquiring knowledge and skills in the delivery of biscuits decorated hand-made (learning the art of decorating, packaging and promotion);
- Empowering young people and raising their capacity to participate actively in the community life by distributing their biscuits with European Citizenship messages; evaluation of those messages impact;
- The promotion and awareness of the principles of equity and social inclusion through the participation in the project of young people unemployed and young people from disadvantaged backgrounds;
- Improving intercultural dialogue and solidarity of young people by spending time together with persons who share the same concerns;
- Improving communication and teamwork skills;
- Develop a positive attitude toward learning experiences, from conflicts and challenges;
- To familiarize participants with the concept of Youth Pass, as a result of the process of non-formal education;
- Reflect on their learning experiences and self-evaluation;
- Strengthening cooperation between the participating youth organizations and between them and other young people;

Who Should Attend :

The project targets are young people who have to fulfill the following conditions:

- Age: between 18 and 30 years;
- Ability to communicate in English (beginner level) and participate in activities throughout its;
- Group of young people will be at least four (two girls, two boys) + 1 leader and up to 8 (4 girls, 4 boys) + 2 leaders / each participating organization;
- Countries: EU Member States, EFTA / EEA countries (Iceland, Norway and Lichtenstein), Turkey, the Western Balkans (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, FYR Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia) and Switzerland.

Preparation:

- Each organization should prepare a max. 10 minutes presentation of the country and the organization
- Bring food and drinks to their traditional cultural evening;

Conditions:

- Meals and accommodation are provided by the host organization;
- There is no participation fee;
- Transportation: Erasmus + foresees a forfeit for travel costs; participants must buy the cheapest plane / train / bus / ferry tickets (taxis and cars are not reimbursed). Participants must keep all travel documents; the reimbursed will be based solely on original documents, on bank transfer during activity or after you return home and send us the original documents.
