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About Bugac

Bugac is located in the middle of the Danube-Tisza Ridge. The village is forty kilometres away from Kecskemét and twenty kilometres away from Kiskunfélegyháza. The village is the main village of the most common known puszta of Hungary and the biggest national park of Hungary (Kiskunsági National Park). Most common traditional sports of the village are the horse sports like horse riding and horse coach-driving. Coach-driving traditions in Bugac provided several world champions as Imre Abonyi, László Juhász, László Kecskeméti. We are also very proud of that Queen Elizabeth II. visited Bugac in 4-7 May 1993 after the capital, Budapest and Kecskemét.

Bugac Shepherd Museum

The Shepherd Museum of Bugac was designed by Joseph Kerenyi and it was built in 1975. Its shape recalls the shape of the old mills. Since its opening it has been the most often visited exhibition unit of the National Park. The traditional tools of nomadic pastoral life are borrowed from the Kiskun Museum of Kiskunfélegyháza. The tree standing in the middle of the circular square was to signify the pasture area. Beside it there is the only wheelbarrow that remained. In the showcases items made of wood, bones, leather and metal are exhibited. Musical folk instruments are also exhibited. The interior recalls the atmosphere of shepherds' flats. In the dioramas we can see the flora and fauna of the Bugac plains. Looking through the museum window we can see the beautiful landscape of the plains, which provides the natural setting to the exhibited materials.



The landscape in many places even today represents the former forested plains. The Lower Plain (Alsópusztá) and the Bugac Forest can be visited along the red cross and the red stripe tourist trails. The red cross trail leads to a lookout tower with a magnificent view over the Native Juniper Grove (Ősborókás), which is a highly protected area and can only be visited strictly following the marked trail or in a company of a professional guide.

The lime-rich sand surface provides home for diverse flora. There are protected plants such as various species of orchids and irises (e.g. the helleborine and the fuzzy linseed) and there are long-term carnations and special species of grass. The area gives home to a large number of insects. An interesting species is a type of grasshopper (with special legs) which occurs on the Great Plain only here. The reptile fauna is also significant from an international aspect, because the endangered meadow viper lives here. The most common mammal is the rabbit.

Afforestation Museum

Forest-steppe was the last natural flora of the Great Plain, characterised by forests, marshes, swamps, loess and sand steppes. At the time of the Hungarian conquest, forests and trees were more abundant on the Great Plain than today.



However, due to developing agriculture and extensive animal husbandry, the landscape has changed. During the Turkish occupation of the 16th-17th centuries, most of the forests on the Great Plain were harvested, which resulted in the expansion of the steppes. This process did not end with the end of the Turkish rule, as revitalizing agriculture took over large forest areas.

Changing hydrological and climatic conditions have led to the development of drift sand. In order to stop drift sand, afforestation of the Great Plain has been a constant effort since the mid-18th century, but with slow progress. Only after the First World War, in 1923, was an act initiating afforestation in alkaline and drift sand areas approved. Since significant afforestation began in 1947, the forested land area of the Great Plain has increased by 300 thousand ha.

The Great Plain's Afforestation Museum in Bugac is a tribute to this enormous undertaking. The exhibition, maintained by the KEFAG Zrt., was opened on the occasion of the Hungarian Forestry Association's congress on 5 August 1984.

The renovated exhibition of the museum shows technical and historical documents, objects, archives and publications of the Great Plain's afforestation.

Visitors can learn about tree planting methods, formerly used machines and tools, climatic and soil conditions and the characteristic wildlife of lowland forests. The exhibition commemorates the foresters and researchers who participated in the afforestation of the Great Plain.

Kiskunsági National Park

One of Hungary's most distinctive geographical areas is the area between the Danube and Tisza River. In order to protect the treasures of nature, in 1975 national park was founded, which was the second in our country. Total protected area is 76,600 hectares, of which more than 51,081 hectares is the nine separate units of Kiskunság National Park, while the rest are nature conservation areas and nature reserves areas.

The largest area of the National Park, Bugac (11,488 hectares), is located in the middle of the Danube-Tisza Ridge. The steep sand hills and sand hill tops are covered by the driest and poorest nutrient-vegetation so it represents the bare sandy open grasslands. Rich flora welcomes the visitors, among the first flowering plants there are flowers like the rare black pasqueflower, striking a vibrant yellow sand cinquefoil, the spring vernal stitchwort, while the small white and brightly colored pansy flower is hiding on the area. From May the colors of the sandy hills' flora of culminates. Besides the *Alkanna tinctoria* and the *Fumaga Vulgaris* the yellow sandy *Sedum* and sandy *Onosama*, sandy *Isis*, and the everlasting flower are not rare. There are some real rarities: the *Astragalus dasyanthus*, colorful blanket of the blue hairy flax in the middle of summer. The sandy crocus flowers in the fall.

On the top of the dunes the poplars regain their strength and they cover smaller or bigger areas. Underneath the juniper, elsewhere the hawthorn, the blackthorn, the *Berberis vulgaris* and the *Ligustrum vulgare* are common. In the undergrowth the *Cephalanthera rubra*, the *Epipactis atrorubens* are not rare. In 1994 a separate species of *Epipactis* was discovered, which is called *Epipactis bugacensis*. All three species belongs to orchids.


The vegetation of the Puszta is completely different from the dunes, much more closed than the dunes. The *Filipendula vulgaris*, *Phleum phleoides* and *Briza* are common. Here is one of the earliest blooming orchid species, the *Orchis morio* and the very rare *Ophrys speghodes*. May is the blooming time of the different species of sage, the Hungarian carnation, and *Polygala comosa*. By the degradation of grasslands the *Festuca rupicolan* is replaced by the *Festuca pseudovina*.

The fauna of Bugac shows similarities with other sandy areas. The hoppers of ant-lion larvae are also frequent in the sand. The adult animals are more difficult to discover. The grasshoppers are the most common. On a hot August day hundreds flew in front of the person walking in the puszta. Walking in the Puszta of Bugac, we can observe the sand caterpillar, the sand lizard, green lizard, brown and green toad.

The birds are the loudest inhabitants of the puszta and of the forests. Most common is: jay, blackbird, ring dove, the nightingale, the turtle dove, and the golden oriole. More and more

often it is possible to see buzzard circulating high. In hollow trees starlings, jackdaws, and rollers nest.

For visitors and hikers the Kiskunság National Park offers a variety of tours. The trails with appropriate infrastructure (designated hiking trails, nature trails, information boards, demonstration sites), makes it possible to discover the nature independently. The visitors have the opportunity to go on a shorter (2-3 hours), providing general information, or longer trips with professional assistance. For groups guided tours are also possible, advanced appointment is necessary. For individuals or family visitors, scheduled organized (5-6 hour) open tours are available. The exact place and date is published in the national park's annual program book.

From the Shepherd Museum a short walk leads to the stables. This is the living place of the yellow Bugac stud, which now has almost a hundred horses and where they breed Kisbér half. Here the visitors can experience the indigenous Hungarian animals: mangalica pig, the grey cattle and racka sheep. Along the way, visitors can see the black puli-haired dogs and the donkeys grazing peacefully.

Our guests can experience the life of the horsemen (they can sit on the horses' back or they can crack the whip)



Hunting possibilities

Hunting clubs provide several possibilities to the guest hunters. Alongside the hunt-hiking, the clubs serve accommodation in the forests in hunter's house.

This is an area for small game and here it is possible to hunt for hare, pheasant and also roe deer. On the area of Bugac, there is a 15,000 ha forest, which offers roe deer shelter in the winter and is also



good for breeding pheasant. Occasionally red deer and wild boar can be found here. Woodcock can also be hunted in this forest. Most roebuck antlers weigh about 300 g, but trophies over 400 g can also be found.

Petermonastery

There is a medieval monastery complex along with the settlement and parish church. The village church has been explored. Documented basis indicates that it is a small, one-aisle medieval church. Excavations are in progress under the IPA program and are performed at the monastery complex.

The first findings referring to this monastery date from the beginning of the 13th century. Previous explorations indicate a monastery complex with the basilica. The monastery walls were made of stone, and documenting of the complex and the monastery itself proceeded from the Eastern region. Preservation of discovered remains of the walls is being performed within the room, the former dining room. Areas and architectural remains discovered so far can be compared with the documented remains of a monastery in Arača. Findings are indicative of a relatively large necropolis, older than the monastery complex. Coins from the necropolis point to the 12th century. Moveable objects, such as coins, jewellery, and relics confirm the former importance of a monastery. The complex is being prepared for the presentation, as well as an introduction of a tourist route through excavations and landscaping of the surrounding area. The Medieval ambiance will be created through presentations of the village church and monastery complex at the appropriate events. The immediate proximity of the National park gives way to a range of possibilities for a variety of offers within the chosen tourist routes.



Let's rent a bicycle at the Culture House and go for a sight by bike in the landscape!

There are 15 bicycles for women and 5 bicycles for men for rent in the garden of the Culture house (Béke Street 27, H-6114 Hungary, Bugac). There are also baby chair for the bicycles, if you would like to ride with your children.

There is a 30 km long bike road passing the village and reaching the different museums of the village. It is a great opportunity to spend some days in Bugac to ride bike and visiting museums or so.

KURULTAJ – A MEETING OF THE TRIBES

Kurultaj is a celebration of preservation of ancient traditions, it serves as a revival of ancient Hungarian and other nomadic cultures, paying tribute to great ancestors.

Within the framework of this event the organizing party builds a large nomadic village that contains many yurts. A large number of horses also participate in this event. To this date, Kurultaj is the largest celebration of ancient traditions in Hungary that gladly welcomes guests, especially from Hun-Turkic nations with whom Hungarians have many historical and cultural ties.

This celebration attracts the people who preserve the ancient Hungarian traditions not only from Hungary, but also Hungarians who live on territories of boarding countries.

Kurultaj takes place in the suburbs of the Bugac village, 160 km south of Budapest, at one of the most beautiful Hungarian steppe areas on the outskirts of Kiskunság National Park. Here you can also find the largest sand dunes in Europe. This region is one of the centers of the Hungarian shepherd culture and equestrian sport.



ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE BIG KURULTAJ

The largest procession of nomadic warrior horsemen in the world was held at the Kurultaj in 2012. It had 230 warrior horsemen in Hunnic, Avar and ancient Magyar armor and also 680 foot soldiers in traditional historical clothing.

Over the years the Kurultaj has achieved many spectacular victories and unique results.

The largest shaman tambourine covered with a single piece of leather was made for the event in 2010. It was 188 cm in diameter and was played during the ignition of the ritual fire.

Archery: at the 2010 Kurultaj, 1120 archers shot arrows simultaneously from traditional bows.

Archery tournament: the best historical result in this competition was achieved in the year 1226 AD by an archer Eshunhei who shot his arrow a distance of 502.5 meters. The new world record has been set in honor of Kurultaj by archer Jozsef Monus who shot his arrow a distance of 603 meters using a traditional bow! In combat archery in 2012 he also managed to shoot into a human figure shaped target from a distance of 400 meters!



Shepherds' day in the Puszta
