

### What:

The aim of the project 'Just arrange it' is to make the partners and young people more aware of their possibilities related to create a social change and becoming more social entrepreneurial. The focus of 'Just arrange it' is to find possibilities in a jobless economy through becoming more entrepreneurial aware of own capacities and possibilities. The project will consist of 2 youth exchanges and an interim period in which the participants find entrepreneurial opportunities for themselves and the sending organisation.

#### How:

The project will be applied for the October deadline within the Erasmus+ programme, KA1 youth. The rough timeline of the project is:

# Why:

The current labour market in Europe is ever changing. Contracts are not being given and the youth unemployment is high. Through this project we want to make the participants more aware of their possibilities in becoming an entrepreneur and increase their skills and competences, in this way they can create their own job and generate an own income. We focus on social entrepreneurship mainly since the interim period can be implemented together with the partner organisation and we have experience and knowledge about this concept.

The exchanges will consist mainly of sharing best practices, giving examples, doing role play games and assignments in the surrounding of the accommodation. No theory will be given since entrepreneurship is all about doing, exploring, networking and going for your goals. Only input, tools and techniques will be provided by the facilitators.

It is not mandatory for the participants to take part in both exchanges, as long as participants take place who are connected to your organisation and who are involved in the local project, it is sufficient for us.

### For who:

The project is for organisations which are working in the local community and which are working with youth aged between 18 and 23. As partner organisation we expect you to prepare the group for the exchanges, coordinate during the interim period the social projects and disseminate & exploit the project results with stakeholders and target groups connected to your organisation. The exchanges are for youngsters aged between 18 and 23 years young. We give preference to

youngsters with fewer opportunities as described by the Erasmus+ programme:

- Educational difficulties
- Economic obstacles
- Cultural differences
- Social obstacles
- Geographical obstacles
