In a larger strategic framework at local and international level, <i>Ianua Australis</i> proposes itself not only as a privileged observatory on present-day society's needs, but also as a proactive player in the necessary process of European integration.

Ever since it was founded, while maintaining a particular focus on young people and youth leaders, <i>Ianua Australis</i> has developed significant skills and expertise in the area of project cycle management, distinguishing itself for the qualitative high-level of its activities (independently and/or in partnership): projects under the Erasmus+ and the European Solidarity Corps programs as well as seminars, workshops and voluntary work.

Founded members of <i>Ianua Australis</i> have a huge longtime experience in voluntary sector and in the development of local communities, working especially with youngsters and youth workers. <i>Ianua Australis</i> has got a strong community-oriented approach: all its members (and volunteers) come from different educational and				



professional paths so that, with all these variegated skills, they are able to include their formal knowledge into non-formal methods to achieve the best possible result. All of this makes <i>lanua Australis</i> always well-informed about the needs of nowadays society (both locally and at European level) and fully involved into the E.U. integration process.

He's graduated with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration and a master's degree in Social Innovation, as project manager, he has many years of expertise in project cycle management.
