About the project:

"The dice is cast" is the first real gaming youth exchange project of FEIS Foundation. It is organize under the Erasmus+ Programme, by 40 person group of youth in 13 - 16 years old from 4 different countries (with active support of their teachers and local schools). Main idea of the project is to conduct as an one big game, that will start even before exchange and finished even after, just with dissemination of its results. This way will help participants to better understanding of financial & market issues, gave them more self-confidence about future plans and bring them to the next level of entrepreneurship. Using intercultural and nonformal learning by mixing all participants in different groups will help them to discover their team abilities, cultural awareness and other "soft" competences. During the exchange, each activity will be suitable for one field of the Game, in which participants will take specific actions to go forward and in the end finished the game in one of possible endings. Moreover there will be no winners or losers, but more experience and more self – awareness participants, well prepared for future challenges. That will be main result, shared with the others by online diaries of each teams, writing day by day with all emotions and practice.

Participants involved in the Project:

We are looking for participants in 13 - 16 aged, interested in entrepreneurship. In particular we would like to cooperate with schools or organizations working with younger students. Participation required involving teachers or other tutors, that will take part on every step of it. FEIS collaborate with local school from its headquarter city and polish teachers are also included in every step of the project.

We estimate that in project will take part 12 participants per country (10+2 leaders) from 3 different EU country (the amount could be smaller if we decided to make it 4 countries – it will depend on recruitment process).

Duration:

9 working days in September of 2016 (specific dates will be settle with all partners after accepting the project by NA).

About FEIS:

Foundation of European Initiatives in Silesia (FEIS) was founded in 2010. Its main objectives are: development of civil society, promoting European awareness, inclusion of people excluded or at risk of exclusion to participate in social activeness, mobilization of young people to participate in public affairs and promotion of cultural and geographical values of polish province - Silesia in Europe.

Since its beginning the Foundation has been proactive in organizing youth exchanges. Until now FEIS had completed five projects from "Erasmus+" Programme and eight projects under the Programme "Youth in Action", during which developed such topics as: future of the European Union, youth entrepreneurship, youth participation in democracy and volunteering in general.

The Foundation also participated as a partner of the third sector in the project Comenius - Regio, implemented by the district of Będzin. FEIS pursued also a number of activities at the local level.
