Project Summary

Our project “YOU CAN TOO!” targets young people that are not aware of their competences and qualifications and who do not possess the proper tools to approach the labor market and become actively involved in their society. Together with our 6 partners we thought of the importance that such a project can have on the life of young people that face unemployment. In this youth exchange we will work on several “do it yourself” projects, recycling as an art form and different creative workshops, in order to challenge young people to show us their hobbies and to try develop them together. We want to work on a set of skills that every entrepreneur owns and to help young people develop their ideas and put them into business ideas. We want to challenge young people to take their hobbies and skills they maybe do not see as potential success and create business out of them.

In order to obtain the envisioned results, together with our partners, we will focus on 3 important aspects for the participants in this project and the beneficiaries of our partner organizations:

- Promoting self-entrepreneurship as a way to combat youth unemployment, an opportunity to enter and remain on the labor market;
- Giving space to ideas that focus on innovation and creativity;
- Acquiring new knowledge and tools that bring value to the professional future of our beneficiaries.

The main aim of our project is to promote alternative ways of professional development in order to combat youth unemployment.

OBJECTIVES

- a) To create an environment that can support mutual growth between 42 participants coming from 7 countries, for the duration of the project.
- b) To develop entrepreneurial skills among the participants, leaders and beneficiaries through the activities envisioned in all the stages of the project.
- c) To promote the benefits of self-development, self-presentation and self-entrepreneurship to the 35 participants and 7 leaders during the implementation stages of the project.
- d) To share the benefits of European programmes and policies targeted towards youth with the local communities through the public events scheduled in all the stages of the project.

When it comes to the objectives sought out by the Erasmus + programme, we will respond to these key objectives: enhancing media literacy, critical thinking and sense of initiative of young people; equipping youth workers with competences and common fundamental values of our society.

Financial Conditions

Accommodation, food and activities during activity days as well as visa costs are fully covered by the project. Travel costs for the meeting will be reimbursed when invoices, e-tickets, boarding passes and other tickets are delivered to the host NGO according to the Erasmus + rules

Methodology

The Program of the Exchange will be built on Non-Formal Education Techniques with a big accent on different techniques of self presentation and empowerment.

Responsibilities and Roles of the partner organizations/groups in the project

- Recruit a group of 6 youngsters which to be able to organize some of the activities, depending on the division of responsibilities decided on prior to the actual exchange.
- Organize the trip to Romania and keep in contact with the project partners.
- Organize seminars/workshops/event upon returning home in order to promote the outcomes of the exchange.

Travel information

Working language: All participants need to be able to actively communicate using English.
