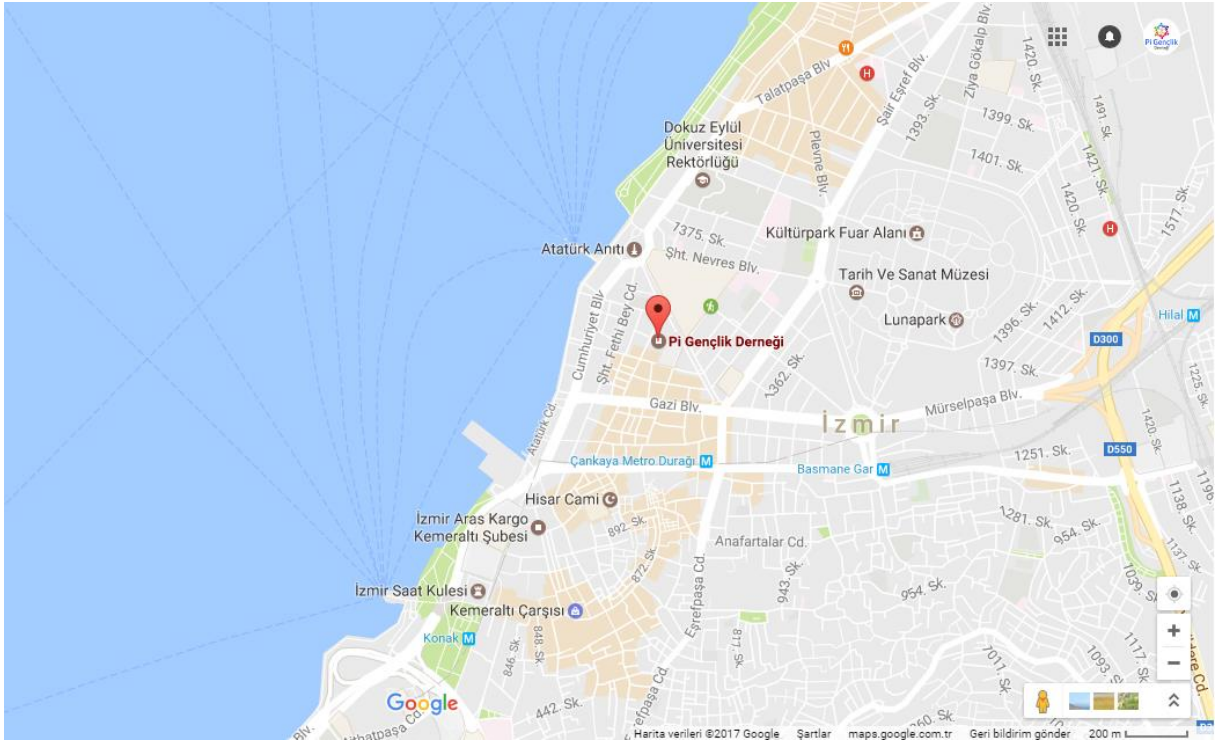

ACCOMMODATION

The volunteers will stay in a rented room and live near family. In the house consisting of 3 rooms and 1 saloon, only 1 room for volunteers will be allocated. Living room(saloon), bathroom and toilet are common use areas. The room where the volunteers stay is only for them and the room has a balcony. The house in which the building is located has a central heating system that operates 24 hours a day. The house where the volunteers will live is on the 7th floor of the 8-storey building. There are photos of the house where the volunteers will live. The home of the volunteers is at the center of the Buca district, where more than 50,000 university students live.

MEALS

Volunteers need to prepare breakfast and dinner themselves at home. Volunteers can eat the food who they wish freely on this. It will be payed money to volunteers for this, in addition to pocket money. And/or the list of requirements will provide by our association up to the budget level for volunteers. During the days when volunteers work at the association, lunch will be provided by association at the restaurant. If you have special needs for vegetarian, diabetes, etc., the host will probably ask for this information before the project. But do not forget to mention it during your application.

POCKET MONEY

We will pay to volunteers monthly pocket moneydetermined by Erasmus Plus program every month. This amount is 80 Euro according to Erasmus Plus program for Turkey. Please plan your personal expenses outside international transportation, accommodation, meals, insurance costs accordingly. You may need to provide yourself additional budget for your additional needs.

LOCAL TRANSPORT

The volunteers' arrival and departure costs from house to office will be covered by the project budget. Transportation between the house where the volunteers will stay and the center of the association is provided by 1 local transport bus. This transportating is running 30 minutes. There is local trasportation 24 hours from the volunteers' home to the city center.

INSURANCE

There will be a comprehensive health insurance for volunteers from the start date to the end of the project. The volunteer will not pay any fees for this insurance. Insurance costs are covered by the project under the program.

TRAVEL

The host and sending organization will provide information about the best alternatives for volunteer access to the project and also volunteer can make the trip plan themselves. The travel expenses of the volunteer to and from the project will be paid up to a total of 250 Euros. It is not just for return or just for return. This amount is the total for arrival and return ticket.

CERTIFICATE

The volunteers will receive a Youtpass certificate issued within the scope of the Erasmus Plus program at the end of the project and an attendance document to be arranged by our association. In addition, a reference letter will be given to the volunteers describing the work and success of the association at the end of the project by board of directors. LANGUAGE SUPPORT and MENTOR

It will be given 3 hours of Turkish language course per week to volunteers. This language course is free. Turkish language courses will be given by volunteers or language courses. In addition, personal counseling support will be provided to the volunteers throughout their stay in Turkey. For this, a mentor staff was established in our association. Mentors will constantly support the volunteers in the process of adapting to my country, to the community, to the region to live. Apart from volunteer mentors, they can also get support from local project managers and local volunteers.

TIME SCHEDULE and PROJECT ENVIRONMENT

Our Association works between 10.00 a.m - 6.00 p.m hours. Volunteers will work between these hours to not exceed 35 hours a week in our association center. The volunteers are permitted 2 days a week Sunday and Mondays. The volunteers will work at the our office and designated project site of our association between specified hours in other days. Our activities like Youth Exchanges and National Volunteer Meeting take place at the hotel or in youth camps. Therefore, volunteers can work in those places in some changing days. The volunteers have got more 2 free days in a month with weekly holiday. Total, they have 24 free days in a year. Without weekly holiday, this free days will organised with volunteer and hosting organisation for use when and how long use by volunteers.
