The Call:

INCA Catalunya is looking for NGOs, youth organisations or informal groups (all Programme and Partners countries will be accepted) to apply on the next ERASMUS+ deadline of February 2017 for the project:

A-TEAM
Advanced Training on European Awareness for Multipliers

This call is only for NGOs, youth organisations or informal groups, not for individuals or participants.

INCA Catalunya understands art and culture as an excellent tool for intercultural dialogue and social integration. The “A-TEAM: Advanced Training on European Awareness” is a project that aims to promote the European need of “interculturality” instead of “multiculturality”. The “A-TEAM” intends to empower the European youth of being promoters of educational and cultural activities providing them with specific tools based on arts and creativity.

The “A-TEAM” project foresees three activities: a training course, an advanced planning visit and a youth exchange.

The main topics of the project are the intercultural dialogue and the European awareness:

- To share the different “images” of “the other” in a European level. To reflect around these different images, as well as the processes of intercultural dialogue in Europe and their current challenges.
- To stimulate the exchange of experiences in an “intercultural” level between youth coming from different European countries, as well as promoting the exchange of good practices between different youth organizations that work with tools based on arts and creativity.
- To stimulate the participants to develop specific competences based in arts and creativity in order to allow more impact in their educational interventions.
- To promote the dialogue and the integration between youth of different European countries.
- To encourage the use of arts and creativity as a tool for the development of competences and individual and collective values.
- To promote the acknowledgement of Non-formal Education as a complementary methodology to Formal Education.

The training course:

During the training course 24 participants will enjoy a stimulating environment, where they will be able to learn and develop new competences through working methods based in arts and creativity. They will discuss main themes of the project and they will have the opportunity to practice what they learnt in the course. Sharing their experiences and their ways of working they will design new initiatives with art and culture as main tools to promote in youth a larger European awareness more open to a dialogue with other cultures.

The youth exchange:

During the exchange, an important pedagogical approach is the “learning between equals”: after the APV, each group of young people, supported by their team leader and the pedagogical team of INCA Catalunya, will organise a session of the week schedule. In this session they will share with the rest of participants their intercultural experiences of their own country. These experiences linked with the work of the sending organisation and the tools (tools based on art and creativity) that their organisation uses in the interventions with youth. Each group will be responsible of “facilitating” the session, “underlining” thereby the horizontality of the learning process.

Partnership and participants:

INCA Catalunya is looking for NGOs, youth organisations or informal groups (all Programme and Partners countries will be accepted). We will select maximum 7 partners. Each partner has to select for the training course 3 participants who work on these fields: animation, street theatre, activist performance, circus, clown, social theatre, with at least 1 year of experience (professional or semi-professional).

For the youth exchange each partner has to participate into the advanced planning visit with one leader and select for the exchange 4 participants and one leader.

Costs:

According with the new ERASMUS+ funding rules, travel costs for selected participants are covered up to a maximum that depends on how far the participant comes from; if the participant spends more than that amount, he/she has to pay the difference. Selected participants will be reimbursed during the training course. Selected participants will have to pay a participation fee of 30 euro for the training course and 15 euros for the youth exchange. Costs for board, accommodation and training are fully covered by the organisers. Visa costs are 100% covered too (let us know if you need the visa).

How to apply:

According with the new rules of ERASMUS+, in order to ensure a valid application, we need from each partner some information:

- First we need your PIC code. Please read carefully the ERASMUS+ Guide if you have any doubt regarding PIC code and the registration of your organisation in the European Commission's Participant Portal.
- We need some information about your organisation, so please fill the Partner Form.
- We need a mandate from your organisation, so please fill, print, sign, scan and send us by email the Mandate.
