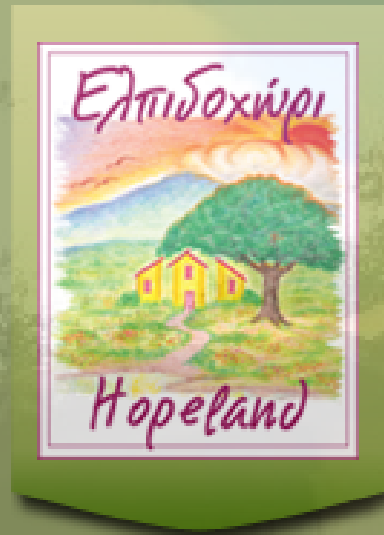

The project

Greenovation is a project about enhancing soft skills of young people by using eco-building as a tool of practical activity to improve the skills and enhance their employability.

12 days in the surroundings of Hopeland, in Argolida Greece to enhance your skills in eco-building and sustainability in practice, build relationships, connect with others and be self-sufficient.

About Hopeland

Hopeland-Elpidohori is a venture that aims at creating and supporting activities for parents children and adults regarding the Environment, Tradition, Culture and Personal Development, while also promoting sustainability in all levels. It aims at setting an example of self-sufficiency. Some of its main objectives are natural building, natural farming, recycling, respect for nature and reducing the ecological footprint.

It is located in a 7.7 acre piece of land in Peloponnese, with age long olive trees and other fruit trees as well as native herbs and it is surrounded by a forest and boasts for 5 oversize yew trees (which are protected by the local Forest Protection Service), as well as a 400-year-old oak tree. It is only 130 kilometers away from Athens, a stone's throw from momentous archaeological and tourist destinations, like Mycenae, Nafplion, Argos, Ancient Nemea, Ancient Tiryns and more.



GREENOVATION HOPELAND

30 volunteers from European countries will visit Hopeland for 12 days where they will have the opportunity to exchange techniques of eco-and natural building, acquire new skills and techniques through practical experience raising environmental awareness and transfer to their communities and enhance self-sufficiency as a powerful tool of self and personal development.

Accommodation will be in the surroundings of the farm, in tents and as a eco-venture vegetarian food will be provided and prepared by Hopeland.

The participants will have the opportunity to enhance their skills in eco-building, sustainability in practice, self-sufficiency, teamwork and cultural exchange.

- **Self-sufficiency skills**- been able to eco-build, gardening, live in a sustainable way
- **Teamwork and cooperation**- work with groups, coordination, build relationships, leadership skills
- **Eco-building** – building in a sustainable way, techniques and tools both theoretical and practical
- **Sustainability in practice**- be in a community that lives in a sustainable way, experience and participate in green living and build new houses.

Greenovation outcomes

For the project

- Exchange ideas, experiences, knowledge and good practices of eco-building between the participants from different countries and thus increase their employability
- To increase awareness of sustainability in practice and how it can be achieved through eco-building and other examples of a sustainable lifestyle and how the youth can enhance and promote the idea of sustainability in their communities
- to enhance teamwork, self-sufficiency, organization and leadership skills to youth leaders and help them acquire the know-how of building and designing a training programme about eco-building and sustainable development and been able to transfer it to their communities
