Alternative Curriculum for Education out of the Wild (ACEWild)

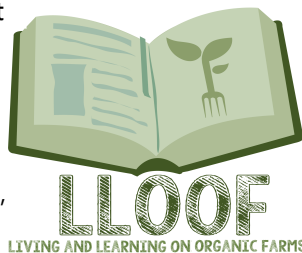
