Changing Places, Changing Lives

International Mobility and Migration in Youth Work

Description:

The "Changing Places, Changing Lives" project is a six-day training course, taking place in Estonia, Pärnu, will gather 28 youth workers from 14 countries to address challenges and opportunities related to international mobility and migration in Europe. The course, based on a range of non-formal methods, targets youth workers, youth leaders and those involved in mobility and migration-related projects for and with young people. Through a structured programme of activities, this project aims at developing participants' knowledge in the field of European mobility and international migration as well as their skills in the field of mobility project work with young people.

Project objectives:

- To foster reflection on different dimensions of migration and mobility (East-West, South-North, internal and international, permanent and seasonal, amongst others) among participants
- To facilitate and exchange of experience and good practice in youth work, related to international migration and mobility and its influence on young people in EU countries
- To train youth workers in addressing the challenges and opportunities resulting from migration with young people in their community
- To equip youth workers with knowledge of European mobility schemes, with particular reference to the EVS scheme and other volunteering programmes and the new Youth on the Move initiative of the European Commission
- To promote European co-operation between youth organisations in the field of migration and youth mobility
- To develop new initiatives in the field of migration and mobility for young people within the framework of the Youth in Action Programme as well as outside of it

Target group:

- Young Workers, Trainers, Volunteers or Social Workers between 18 to 30 years old
- participants that have an active attitude and have interest to work with migrant population

Group and duration:

All Youth in Action Programme – *programme countries* (EU + EFTA+Turkey+Croatia) are eligible to apply. We aim at youth organizations from at least 14 countries represented by at least 2 participants each. All in all 28 participants. Duration (without travel days) will be **6 working days**.

Accomodation and lodging covered by 100% by the Youth in Action programme. Travel expences covered by 70% by the Youth in Action programme. Participation Fee: 25 Euros
