

Maghweb is a dynamic addition to the increasingly Sicilian non-profit sector. Based in the heart of Palermo, we aim to provide local organisations with communication expertise that is tailored to the specific needs of the third sector. As a team, we have extensive experience in the field of journalism, videomaking, documentaries, environmental education and eco-friendly sustainability. The objective of our association is to improve the efficiency and visibility of activities related to social integration and international cooperation through the efficient use of communication. We are costantly seeking to expand our activities at a European level.

Our main projects:

- Project Maghweb was implemented from December 2012 and Septemper 2013. It was a project in collaboration with a group of tunisian youths from Radio3R from Regueb (Tunisie) in which Maghweb managed the communication plan and the activities of "Femme Solidaire" center of Jendouba, a center that fosters female equality after the Tunisian Revolution. Equivalent activities were held in collaboration with the "Association des Arts pour le Cinéma and the "Theatre d'El Kef".
- "iDoc", youth Exchange (KA1) on environment protection and intercultural dialogue, that took place in Palermo in May 2015. It involved 18 youths coming from Geece and Italy.
- "Tell Me Euromed", youth Exchange (KA1) on mediaterranean knowledge and intercultural dialogue, in Jenuary 2016. It involved 24 youths coming from France, Egypt and Spain.
- You. & M.E.", youth Exchange (KA1) on minorities discrimination encouraged by European media. It was held in Palermo in February 2016 and engaged youths from France, Italy, Hungary and Estonia.
- "Graphic Youth", youth Exchange (KA1) on illustrated narrative as a non-formal tool to combat discrimination and knowing European reality. It took place in March 2016 and involved youths from Portugal, Hungary, Czech Republic and Spain.
- "Hit The Wall", youth Exchange(KA1) on the street art as a form of integration to promote intercultural dialogue and the restoration of suburbs. It was in April 2016. It engaged 28 youths coming from Italy, Spain, Poland and Romania.
- "The Sound of Silence", is a Capacity building project (KA2) on women violence. Maghweb collaborates with an Indian and a Colombian Organisation . It will be held from April 2017 to the August 2018.
- "Ballarò Buskers is an International Festival of street artists". In 2016 the festival involved 30 international artists, 100 events with more than 10.000 audience.
