AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Our project is Mobility of Youth Workers Project in Erasmus+ Programme which will be held in [Antalya](#), Turkey. Our project will be continued for around 8 months and 9 days of it will be activity.

This project's main aim is improving capacity and knowledge of youth work by sharing different experiences, knowledge and backgrounds. About the project main theme, Therapeutic hippopotamus (hippotherapy) has many uses in psychological, physiological, physical and social areas and is applied to many patient groups. Youth work changes many things in genocide. We have observed the consequences of these changes with our youth activities. In addition, a sufficient number of people can not be reached because many of the organizations and countries that carry out youth work can not disseminate their work. To ensure that the project, besides expanding other intentional youth work, places the disadvantaged groups in these activities operating abroad. The countries involved in the project are expected to spread this work in their own countries and lead the treatment of young people with autism and Down's syndrome.

Our aims and objectives about this project are:

- ✓ Dissemination of new methods in youth work in ensuring social participation of disadvantaged youth,
- ✓ Youth workers are able to reach the targets, animals are used as vehicles in the positive direction,
- ✓ Improve the rough motor skills of disadvantaged youth to reduce the stresses on balance and upright posture.
- ✓ Preparing for disadvantaged young and societal communication with the individuals involved in youth work
- ✓ Developing sense of responsibility for animals by teaching animal love and care to the individuals who will participate in youth work
- ✓ Countries to be included in the project to disseminate the project in their own countries
- ✓ Increase and strengthen international youth work
- ✓ Supporting cooperation and exchanges between youth workers from different countries
- ✓ Capacity building by sharing different experiences and good practices among youth workers,
- ✓ Improving quality of youth work and increasing visibility of youth projects

TO PROJECT PARTNERS

We are expecting from our project partners to share their ideas, experiences and documents (such as youth policies) about project topic and youth work. Each country group consists of **7 participants** (1 group leader and 6 participants (1 participant Down's syndrome or Autistic)) to attend this project.

Although there is no age limit in mobility of youth workers projects, we kindly request from our partner organizations to select participants between age **18 and 40 (group leaders)**.

We are also expecting from them to present their cultures and organizations.

We will organize intercultural expos for all participant countries and each country will present and show their country, culture in an interesting and impressive way beyond national food and drink.

For the program, we will present our experiences in youth work by presentation and we will be thankful if you contribute to the program by sharing interesting games, energizers.

We may ask to do some tasks from all participants or groups before the program.

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION

Participants need to arrange their local transportations in their countries to the airport. They also need to book their flight tickets on **14 October 2017** as an arrival date and **22 October 2017** as a departure date.

As you all know, you will be paid the amount of money in "Euro"s which are decided by distance calculator of Erasmus+ Programme. You will be paid in "Euro"s, regardless of the amount and currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Currency and Money Exchange: Euros can easily be exchanged across Turkey.

It is not constant but nowadays 1 Euro \approx 3,90 TRY (TL-Turkish Liras).

Weather: In October, Antalya is usually warm and sunny. Average temperature will be around between +15 and +25 degree Celsius. In any case, please prepare yourself for rainy day(s).

Health Insurance: The health insurance is not provided and will not be reimbursed by the organizers. All participants are strongly advised to purchase private travel insurance.

Personal Needs: Although training center is close to the city, please be sure that you have your personal care products, vitamins and all the things you need with you.

ORGANIZER(S)

As a informal group of youth workers, we have different backgrounds on youth work. Our group members are working as youth and sports experts, leaders, volunteers for Republic of Turkey, Ministry of Youth and Sports and also NGOs. We named our informal group as the "**YoutWAY**".

As a group of youth workers, we are professionally organizing international youth exchanges, projects under different youth organizations.

We are aiming to share our experiences, knowledge and background in youth work. We are also willing to get into European youth work and gain different experiences in youth work both individual and organizational level.

DATES (ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE)

Arrival : 14 October 2017

Departure : 22 October 2017

All groups and participants need to be in [Antalya Airport](#) the exact dates that are mentioned. The organizers will inform/help you to get to the venue.

LOCATION/ACCOMMODATION

Location : Antalya, Turkey

Accommodation: Participants will be sharing rooms with 1 and 2 other people/person of the same sex, each room has a bathroom. There are towels and bed lines.

The organizers will give detailed information about the location and accommodation before the program.

The project will be organized in a hotel as a facility which is located close to the **seaside**. Participants can also get prepared to swim and fun by bringing their swimsuits, sun-cream, other stuffs.

CERTIFICATE

The participants will receive at the end of the course a Youthpass certificate. Validating the learning experience of participants is important in itself and the document can be of benefit in terms of the educational or employment future of the participant. Through Youthpass the European Commission ensures the Youth Exchange activity is recognized as a non-formal learning experience.
