Description of the project

Contributions of the project

Cultural focus:

The project will help **tackle the issue of tolerance** through the discovery of someone else's culture. It will also help **develop the pupils' curiosity** about another culture.

- understand a foreign language and speak in another language;
- communicating on a daily basis;
- holding a conversation in a foreign language.
