The project will explore (via a series of creative workshops) different forms of collective art-making and will discuss the effects of the group art-processes over the individuals and groups participating in them. The project participants will experience oil finger painting, working with wool, bread-making, decoupage, and other forms of collaborative art-making presented by representatives of the project partners.
