Short Overview

Social media have reached everyday life to an extent that it seems to be impossible, that there was social life without media before. Web 2.0 opens up possibilities of interactivity and self-exposing to an extent that have never been reached before. Users of social media most often are not conscious about the mechanisms in the background. Most of the users are simply swamped with the necessary special knowledge.

A <u>general goal</u> of this TC is to perform in a conscious way within social media. Therefore it is headed towards people, who are involved in the pedagogic work with young people. For this purpose there will be done practical as well as theoretical references to theatrical performances. We will view the acting on stage as well as backstage and we will make practical experiments about that. The findings will be transformed into an internet-performance.

Furthermore social media in particular offer a chance of participation in social life to <u>disadvantaged</u> and underprivileged adolescents. The lack of mobilisation for these people can be counterbalanced by participation via social media. So therefore inclusion and chances can be raised. The possibilities for performances in social media give way to a higher chance for self-manifestation of discriminated groups for to reduce prejudices and correct stereotypes and for to go public about injustice.
