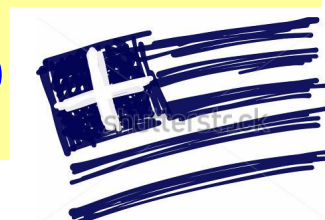



Main aim / Objectives: 	To increase skills and competences of youth educators / various multi-players by providing them with knowledge and approaches in the field of anti-discrimination education along with the promotion of advantages deriving from co-existence and co-operation in diverse , multi-cultural societies. Objectives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • defining and understanding the concept of diversity, • setting the comprehensive grounds for stereotypes & prejudice for individuals and groups of people, • experiential surfacing of causes-effects of discrimination, • exploring/understanding the multi-dimensional nature of identities (on personal and group level), • experiencing minority-majority relations, • analyzing the role and influence of discrimination language in folk culture, colloquial and media language (hate speech), • creating resourceful ways to raise awareness, shape anti-racist mentality and influence public opinion, • contriving ways of opposing to discrimination and sharing experiences and good practices among youth workers.
Methods:	NFE methods: workshops, exercises, debates, simulations, games, discussions, presentations, reflections, digital tools. <i>(individually-in pairs-in small groups-in the plenary)</i>

Main programme themes:	<p>Sensitiveness to diversity, stereotypes, prejudice, discrimination, multi-dimension of identities, majority-minority relations, exclusion-inclusion, racism, equality language, media effect, hate speech, anti-discrimination education.</p>
