Background

- To inform and support the development of youth policies in Turkey

Activities:

- Online surveys in all partner countries
- Regional Meetings with young people in Turkey
- Study Visit in 1 partner country (4 days meeting in a partner country where we can meet with NGO representatives & young people and discuss the project topics)
- Final Conference in Turkey (2-3 representatives from each partner)

Budget of the project:

The accommodation, food and visa for all participants will be covered in total by project budget. Travel costs up to limited amounts for countries according to programme rules of Erasmus+. Each participant has to provide us invoice, flight tickets and boarding cards to organizer.
