When: 1st July – 10th July

Where: Burgos, Spain

Who: 3 participants from 6 different countries

SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

Six organizations will participate in the seminar which will involve members of the public administration, and experts in the field of social inclusion at the local level, as educators and social workers.

During the seminar, participants will have the opportunity to share and understand the potential of non-formal education as an educational and inclusive method. In the same way as to deepen the knowledge of all participants regarding the opportunities offered by the Erasmus + program in international mobility and social inclusion. Having this as a starting point, the participants will develop the following competences:

- development and exchange of good practices in the social inclusion of less opportunities in local and international projects;
- ability to analyze needs: Participants will have the opportunity to learn what are the main needs of the entities involved and how they can be addressed in a common purpose;
- capacity for understanding, mediation and collaboration that will be developed in an international environment that includes the participation of different professionals;





 commitment and synthesis capacity: the participants must reach a shared agreement on common quality standards in the participation of fewer opportunities in international exchange projects that will be carried out in the selection, creation and management phases of the group of exchange that will continue

Main goals

- Discuss the social inclusion from the political point of view of youth workers in the associative and youth sectors;
- Create a European Informal Network of partners that work for the inclusion of young people with fewer opportunities at local and international level;
- Promote the Erasmus + program and opportunities for international mobility and discover how it is useful to promote the objectives of social inclusion;
- Offer an opportunity for intercultural learning through non-formal education;
- Develop an important link between the political world and the citizen, working together towards a single objective.





YOUTH EXCHANGE

When: 9th October – 16th October

Where: Burgos, Spain

Who: 5 people from 6 countries (18 to 25) + 1 group leader from each country (+18)

SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

The aim of the Youth Exchange is to offer a new point of view of the "different" with the organization of activities, times for the intercultural meeting that will lead young people to know the realities often stereotyped, like the situation of the homeless, of migrants, of children who live in situations of risk, and so on. The project will be carried out through three media: photography, video production and journalism, and will give you the possibility to become aware of the reality of social exclusion present in our territory as the community lives these realities and what really does to change this perception.

Main goals

- Promote the meeting between different cultures, different people with different experiences and life stories;
- Support the dialogue on social inclusion between local and international organizations;
- Develop practical skills in photography, journalism and video;
- Create a final event on the subject of social inclusion through the methods of the means used during the project;
- Create a social promotion campaign on social inclusion (a spot, a short film, a documentary, etc.);
- Provide the group the opportunity to reflect on the concept of "other" and "different",
 on our prejudices and stereotypes that offer different points of view;
- Offer participants an intercultural learning experience in a context different from that in which they live every day;





- Promote the Erasmus + program and the values of equality and social inclusion;
- Introduce the Erasmus + program and the "Asociación Brújula Intercultural" within the community where it develops its projects





Travel costs and participation fee

The travel costs will be covered up to the amount based on distance calculator. Food and accommodation will be 100% covered. A participation fee of 25€ per participant will be deducted from the travel costs reimbursement (i.e. having 275€ of travel costs if you spend 250€ of travel costs or less you don't have to pay any participation fee).

Accommodation

The Seminar + the Youth exchange will be held in the province of Burgos. The venue is essential and adequate to host the entire group. The selected venue has different activity rooms with all the necessary facilities which we can use.

Transport

The way to arrive in Burgos is simple, the airport of Madrid is only two hours away from the city of Burgos (there are other airports with low cost trips in cities close to Burgos, as well as Santander) and it has a regular bus service connected with Burgos.
