





### **A**RRIVAL

The Ludwig-Windhorst-Haus is located 5km north from the center of Lingen at the district Holthausen.

By car you can reach the house from north or south via the A31, exit Wietmarschen. Follow the signs to Holthausen.

Reaching the house over the B70, choose exit Biene/Holthausen and follow the signs with "LWH".

Coming from the center of Lingen, follow the hotel route until the traffic circle opposite to the petroleum refinery. There you turn in the direction of Holthausen and follow the signs with "LWH". Please refer to "Parking" on the back of this brochure.

By train you take the train to the train station Lingen Ems. Lingen is conected to the Münster-Rheine-Emden railway. From the station, the bus line 71/171 runs hourly towards Holthausen ( see "Bus" on the back).

### **A**rrival/Departure
