#### 1. Preface

Looking for a place in society young people need support and help of that very society and its institutions in order to provide them with the opportunity for expression and personal growth as individuals and as members of the community. Success or failure in adolescent and young adult age are very important, so that investment in the welfare of young people is essential for any society that seeks progress and development. Happy and healthy people do not arise from nothing. They begin their journey as happy and healthy young people.

Youth of our community we see a huge resource development and the future, especially at a time of rapid economic and social change and advocate for the favor of the young people who will use the family, community and society. It is a policy that will enable young people to offer their ideas that will in time be considered and accepted, and understood. It is the policy responsibility of the local community to its young citizens.

Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje shows a clear and long-term commitment Prijepolje municipality to create social, educational, cultural, material, political and other conditions for the permanent benefit of youth and their active, full and responsible participation in the community.

Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje also establishes the basic principles of care for young people and the work plan by which the Assembly Prijepolje provides the basic tasks of the competent services within the local government. This is open invitation to all establishments and institutions of local government, civic associations and religious communities and political parties to make joint efforts contribute to the achievement of common goals for the benefit of youth.

Local action plan for youth in particular highlights the importance of Prijepolje opštedruštvenog action in the areas of:

- Active participation of youth in society
- Youth Information
- Culture and Leisure Youth
- Formal and informal education as a function of professional, personal and social realization of youth
- Self-employment and youth entrepreneurship
- Youth health
- Youth in Conflict with the Law
- Ecology and Sustainable Development.

Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje involves young people in planning and implementation, providing them equal opportunities, information, resources and support to adequately meet the needs of young people in Prijepolje and offer solutions problems in the period from 2010. 2015. year, including all relevant stakeholders of the local community.

#### 2. Document, which relies on local action plan for youth Prijepolje (LAP)

Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje stems from several important European and international documents that define the strategic directions of development of youth. Documents that support the LAP are: White paper (European parlamet), the European Charter on youth participation in municipal and regional life (Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of Europe), national youth policy as a working sample form and add document Education of Young People: Statement 21. century, eleven indicators for the development of national strategies and policies for youth presented by Peter Lauretzen, Deputy Director for Youth and Sport of the Council of Europe and adopted by the European Youth Forum. In addition to these important documents, the Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje, relies on the findings and declarations of the European and world conferences and meetings: the UN World Youth Forum (Braga, 1998.), The World Conference of Ministers Responsible for Youth (Lisbon, 1998), Meeting of Ministers of Education (Bologna 1999)..

The main national document to which the Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje draws a *National Youth Strategy of the Republic of Serbia* by the Serbian Government unanimously adopted the 9th May 2009. year. On the Strategy was attended by more than 16,000 young people, 30 resource centers, 12 ministries, 10 units to monitor and support, eight thematic groups, the six Advisory Committees, and held in 167 tables and 10 regional conferences.

In addition to this document that are directly related to youth policy (youth policy vision, targets and concrete measures by which these policies can be implemented), we used the following national documents: the Poverty Reduction Strategy in Serbia, National Strategy for Employment for the period 2005 - 2010. years, the National Action Plan for Children, the Millennium Development Goals in the Republic of Serbia, Strategy to improve the situation of people with disabilities, Youth Health Development Strategy in the Republic of Serbia; National Strategy to Combat HIV / AIDS, the Adult Education Strategy in

#### 3. The target group which includes the Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje

Adulthood as a different period of life is determined and defined by the world, European and national institutions and organizations. When it comes to young people in Europe, we usually mean age between 15 and 24 years. Republic of Serbia in terms of some defined benefit young people aged 15 to 26 years, but the period of adolescence in many cases extending to thirty years, because of longer duration of education and employment difficulties, and delays growth and social independence. That is why the Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje the actions of the well-being of young people aged from 15 to 30 years in accordance with the National Youth Strategy of the Republic of Serbia

Young people who are engaged in local action plan for young people living in the territory of Prijepolje Prijepolje, are different and social status, as well as national, religious, political, sexual and other commitments. They are active in civic associations, youth groups, informal groups, a number of them has a physical disability, is engaged in sports, volunteer work, or another action is completely passive and does nothing.

#### 4. Analysis of the initial state

#### Socio-demographic characteristics of Prijepolje municipality

The birth rate in the municipality of Prijepolje almost always been upward, often above the average in Serbia. Last decade is characterized by the decline in population in the municipality of Prijepolje, mainly due to emigration. According to the 1991 census. , in the municipality of Prijepolje lived 46,525, and the 2002nd year, when he carried the latest census, 41,188 inhabitants. For a decade, has reduced the number of 5337 inhabitants. Every year, on average, the population was shrinking by more than 1%.

Emigration of the population and declining birthrate deteriorating age structure, as illustrated by the data from the table:

From the table it can be concluded that the number of young people in permanent decline. In a survey conducted by Civic Initiatives NGO volunteers and new vision - the Youth Club from Prijepolje the question "If you got the chance, would you leave Prijepolje - even 84.10 per cent of young people gave an affirmative answer, mainly because of better employment (32.33 percent).

A significant percentage of young people covered by formal education. Eighth grade (15 years) in the 2008/2009 school year 493 students attended. In Prijepolje municipality currently has 1000 primary less than a decade ago, and each new school year to remain empty for at least three classrooms. Of the 35 primary schools in every three to attend elementary school less than 5, while in four separate classes teach only two students. In the last three years have closed three schools (Kaćevo, Mileševo So, justice)

Secondary education in the municipality of Prijepolje takes place through the work of Prijepolje gymnasium, Economic Trade and Technical School. Opened, 2005. year, and the only higher education institutions - high school technical vocational studies Cacak, the Consultative Center Prijepolje.

The number of young, 15 years, included education in the school year 2007/2008, year:

Youth education plays a significant role in employment. According to the National Employment Service Branch in Prijepolje of 31.01.2009, the total number of unemployed young people (under the National Strategy for young people between 15-30 years.) Amounted to 1,911 persons, or the total number of registered unemployed is about 30%, of which 1062 women or 56% of the total number of young people looking for a job. The majority of this long-term unemployed, since the jobs are waiting for more than a year. Profile of Education is very important determinant of future employment. According to the National Employment Agency, Branch in Prijepolje of 31.01.2009. was about 22% of unemployed youth among the unskilled or semi-skilled work force that is. Persons without occupation or expertise, 72% of those are third and fourth level education, while about 6% of young Prijepolje who are unemployed have higher education, for which there is weak demand in the labor market. Among unemployed young women who make up 56% youth unemployment, about 26% of population with no qualifications, 69% of women had secondary education and about 6% of young women with higher or university education.

What is a serious data analysis but also opens up opportunities to take on that front than hire professional institutions is the fact that most young people based on their employment with the employer, while the much smaller number of those who choose to self-start a private business. According to the National Employment Agency, Branch in Prijepolje, in 2008. years by using self-support starting a new business was used by only 8 young people. According to program a new employment-support employers who create new jobs in 2008. vol. to the National Employment Service Branch in Prijepolje 39 young persons have found employment, and 21 of the user is a member of the female.

Health is not merely the absence of disease but a state of complete mental, physical and social well-being "(WHO definition)

Health and youth should have been synonymous, but in practice not so. Analysis of the health of young people (population od15 to 30 years) in the Municipality of Prijepolje was performed with special emphasis on the adolescent population (15-19 yr.) Najvulnerabilnijoj population, due to physical and mental maturity and susceptibility to various influences. As a starting point served Reports on compulsory medical examinations of high school youth (conducted by the Pediatric Health Center) and reports on research needs and situation of youths in Prijepolje first

Health problems present in the young population does not differ much from the problems of youth in developed areas:

#### Improper diet

Advertising and availability of fast food, propagation modeling looks in our society that result in diseases of malnutrition (obesity, anorexia, bulimia).

#### Physical inactivity

Computers, mobile phones, and commercialization of sports has led to a decrease in physical activity, which in the period of intense growth and development, resulting in increasing numbers of young with deformities of the spine, chest and feet.

#### Substance Abuse

Stunning data to the <sup>two</sup> biggest problems in the municipality in second place is drug abuse, immediately after unemployment, and other addictions, are not far away on the scale of the problem.

#### Reproductive Health

Early sexual relations, unwanted pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases are certainly present in our environment.

The Health Insurance Act (Ordinance on the content and scope of medical care from the compulsory health insurance), government, the question of prevention and early detection of disease, through health and educational work, and other systematic reviews and 26 year, a woman in connection with pregnancy and systematic reviews of the adult population. In this way the young population can be in the health center and

its services to get advice on developing healthy lifestyles and disease prevention. Law on Health Protection (Regulation of the plan network of health institutions) in the municipality with at least 7000 children from 0 -18. years can be arranged counseling for youth. In our community there is a trend of declining fertility and do not have the number of children scheduled for counseling, but health problems impose the necessity of continuous work with young people to adopt healthy lifestyle and taking care of their own health (and not just through the campaign periodic actions, such as Healthy Schools, Schools without drugs, breastfeeding Sunday ...).

\*\*\*

Level of juvenile crime in the municipality of Prijepolje noted a sharp increase in recent years (Report of the Expert Team of the Center on the situation of juvenile delinquency in 2008.). In 2008. were registered over 180 children and youth with behavioral disorders (offenders, prekršajci and children with antisocial behavior) which is 30 more than last year. There has been also a sharp increase in juvenile crime in the total crime in the municipality. Alarming is the fact that the number of crimes they did juveniles also increased and is 39, which is 10 more than in 2007. The level of aggressiveness of juveniles grow, and to tolerate frustration is lowered. Due to rapid expansion of juvenile delinquency, the existing institutions that deal with these problems as part of regular activities, are not able to amortize this phenomenon and make a significant step in reducing and preventing deviant behavior of youth.

Center for Social Work Prijepolje in 2008. year of its services included 9 persons (15-18. years) without parental care, 48 socio-economically disadvantaged persons (15-18.godina); 151 persons (15-18 years) from families with troubled relationship between the parents; 41 persons affected by the development (15-18 years) Other: 260 persons of 15-18. years.

If in a short period of time does not start with a new way of working with this population, further progressive increase in juvenile delinquency, which the company will not be able to control. It is known that an offender on the average of three new recruits, which means, to the current 180 number could increase to 540 offenders annually. Consequences of this phenomenon would be affected a great number of families, schools and other institutions at the community level.

No data from the Ministry of Internal Affairs - Branch of Prijepolje younger than 14 to 30 who are in the last 3 years come into conflict with the law is not encouraging.

In the last three years young people have committed 319 crimes and 513 violations (data not related to traffic) and it is evident that the number of perpetrators of crimes from year to year increases and the number of offenders is decreasing.

Of the total number of perpetrators of crimes under the age of 14-16. years were 32 times the perpetrators, 16-18. years, 26 times; of 18-21. years, 12 times, and 21-30. years, 249 times. The place of performance in most cases the open space, and the time the crime was a period of 01-04 hours.

The most common perpetrators of violations are the young age of 18-21 years, although it is alarming that the number of increases in this age group.

It is worrying that young people of 14-16. years, more frequent perpetrators of violations and that the number in 2006. the age of 17, increased in 2007. year to 56, in 2008. this number is 53

As the scene of the offense in the first place is the street, then restaurants, and as the most time of the offenses is a period of 22-06 hours, then comes time from 12-18 hours, and then a period of 18-22 hours.

Due to the large number of youth with antisocial and delinquent behavior, Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs with the support of UNICEF equipped Day Centre for young people who are in conflict with the law. Day care center will begin operations in 2009. Year and will function as an extended activity of the Center for Social Work in Prijepolju. Finansiraće up from the local government and donors. Day Center is the only center of its use in Southwest Serbia.

\*\*\*

Cultural life in the municipality of Prijepolje takes place through the work of three cultural institutions: Central library"Vuk Karadžić"Museum Prijepolje and Culture Centre.

Central Library"Vuk Karadžić" ended December 2008. There's 5592, of whom over 30% are young. Young people from the suburbs it is possible to use library services (books, magazines, multimedia, internet) through the operation of mobile libraries - Infobusa.Od 2006th The present trend of increasing numbers of young people who use the library for informational, educational or entertainment purposes. Museum and Cultural Center periodically organize youth programs and support the gathering of informal groups of young people involved in amateur creativity.

\*\*\*

In Prijepolje there are volleyball, football, basketball and rafting clubs, there is the recognition of karate, kick boxing and fitness club bringing together a large number of young people. Prijepolje extensive sports facilities for basketball and football, while Lima's coast over the summer turns and volleyball courts during the tourist events that are being held and which attract great attention of young people. Courts generally have no lighting at night, which is a big problem in summer time for sports activities at night, involving a large number of young people.

According to data from the Sports Federation Prijepolje in our community, there are 23 sports clubs which bring together members of the 1185 (football, volleyball, basketball, karate, hikers, scouts, paragliding, kick boxing, fishing, athletics, kayaking, skiing). Prijepoljska municipality has: a sports hall, four sports halls, two stadiums, 6 courts for small sportive, an outdoor pool (unavailable) and 1-om the sports hall which was the project completed and is expected to be renovated.

\*\*\*

Problems related to the ratio of young to the ecology resulting from the overall community relations to the environment, its values and the need to preserve it. So we can say that a low level of environmental awareness and knowledge levels of young Prijepolje related to ecology and environmental protection - the lack of non-formal environmental education, an insufficient number of young activists, the lack of a strategic approach and a common vision and a lack of concrete solutions and actions.

Active participation of youth in creating a healthy and unpolluted environment is a primary goal. Investment in environmental education and youth environmental education of highly skilled personnel would lead to the creation of a determined public opinion that respect, understand and protect our environment and natural resources.

#### 5. Defining the problem areas to deal with Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje

#### Active participation of young

Almost no young people involved in decision making at the local level. Direct consequence of this fact is insufficient appreciation of the needs of youth and lack of familiarity with the use of their resources, which affect the complete marginalization of youth in the community. Also, often the absence of support for young people to take the initiative, the active role and responsibility in the community. The reasons for this are manifold:

- 1. Insufficient awareness of the necessity of youth participation in decision making;
- The lack of an adequate model of including youth in decision-making processes, even those decisions that are directly related to the development of young people and improving their position in society;
- 3. Discrimination against young people in decision making. Young people are under-represented in institutions and decision-making bodies because there are still prejudices that young people did not have the expertise for such a position.

#### **Youth Information**

- 1. The lack of an adequate model of youth information. Insufficient material resources for the development of youth information. Insufficient to support the development of human resources for youth information.
- 2. Lack of youth programs in the local media. Not enough media space for youth activities. Insufficient adaptation of media content young people. Insufficient involvement of young people in youth outreach programs in the existing local media.
- 3. Lack of school newspapers. Insufficient training of youth for work in the media.

#### **Culture and Leisure Youth**

- **1.**Infrastrukturni and resource problems: Insufficient utilization and availability of existing space for programs and youth initiatives, insufficient financial support for youth initiatives.
- **2.** Maladaptive cultural institutions to the needs of young people: The cooperation between cultural institutions, schools, civic associations, informal groups of young people is very poor, inadequate information existing ways of informing young people are out of step with the needs and habits of young and uninformed youth contributions and interest of local media; Insufficient activity focused on animation, including the promotion of youth; current activities of the scope and content do not meet the needs of young people; Maladjustment cultural institutions and sports for disabled persons because of architectural barriers.
- **3.** Problems related to young people as consumers of culture: Young people are mostly poorly informed, passive and uninterested in the creative expression and refinement of everyday life, there is a tendency of accepting mass trends, conformism youth neiskazivanje own needs in order to influence the creation of supply.

4. Problems related to time of young people: poor and nesadržajna offer; disorganized time of youth; insufficient availability of content - indoor sports halls, sports grounds at all; complete marginalization of youth with disabilities and young disabled people are to; Lack of professional staff working with young people, lack of promotion of healthy lifestyles, low quality and diverse programs for young people in suburban and rural areas, lack of mobility (mobility) of the students - inertia, lack of interest in the field of mobility, communications, exchange of experience and lack of youth people with driving energy, creative ideas and motivation to influence the current situation and contribute to

# Formal and informal education as a function of professional, personal and social realization of youth;

#### Formal education

- **1. Problems related to the system are** outdated, too extensive work programs adjusted to changes in society and the needs of youth, and maladjustment of education and labor market needs.
- **2. Problems related to the educational process:** disordered and non-equipped operating rooms, lack of modern means and devices, a lack of financial resources for higher quality and more varied extracurricular activities, outdated teaching methods, lack of openness to experience from the school environment, nesaradnički a relationship between student-teacher insufficient involvement of parents in school life and work. Nemogućnosrt continuing education of young people with disabilities at the end of primary school.
- **3. Problems related to the teaching staff:** lack of professional development of teachers, lack of professional and material motivation of teachers.
- **4. Issues relating to youth:** lack of motivation and knowledge of students as subjects to participate well in all phases of **instruction.**

#### <u>Informal education</u>

**1. Problems related to the promotion of informal education:** an unsatisfactory status and evaluation of informal education, lack of promote the role and importance of

informal education in personal and professional lives of young people, not enough information about the programs of informal education.

- **2. Problems related to the programs of informal education:** poor availability of the program; insufficient support informal education of young people, leading to a reduced number of programs and / or decline in the quality of the program; insufficient motivation of young people to plan and organize leisure time, acquire useful knowledge, skills and habits through volunteer work and participating in informal education programs.
- **3. Problems related to the implementers of the program:** limited supply of organizations that are engaged in informal education, formal closure of educational institutions and lack of flexibility for multi-sector work leading to difficult cooperation between schools, NGOs, institutions, media, associations, clubs and other entities that carry out programs of informal education.

#### Self-employment and youth entrepreneurship;

- **1.** Insufficient motivation of young ljudih for professional achievement Lack of information on job opportunities, lack of empowerment of youth.
- **2. Lack of support for youth to start self-employed** Lack of measures to promote employment and self employment of young people.
- **3.** Weak and inter-institutional cooperation Lack of cooperation between educational institutions, local governments, businesses, NGOs and the National Employment Service.
- **4. Under-developed entrepreneurial skills among young people** Lack of encouraging the development of entrepreneurial spirit and entrepreneurial environment among young people

#### Youth health

1st Insufficient awareness of healthy lifestyles and lack of support for proper mental and physical development of young people in the areas of: development of a healthy and stable personality in young people, recreation, nutrition and reproductive health.

**2. The lack of organized and continuous work on** *prevention:* substance abuse (nikotinizam, alcoholism, drug abuse), sexually transmitted diseases and HIV, mental health problems in children and adolescents, aggressive behavior and violence.

**3. Inadequate health care for young people:** lack of organization, tailored, accessible and promoted health care for young people, especially for marginalized groups.

#### Youth in Conflict with the Law

- **1. Problems related to family relations:** decline of values in **society**, dissatisfaction with family **relationships**, neglect of family problems, poor family role **models**, **the** entry of young people in conflict with the law as a way of drawing attention to the family.
- **2. Problems related to educational and other institutions:** the lack of adequate educational and preventive measures (PAS, psychological problems), lack of adequate mechanisms to mitigate the social and societal differences, the poor economic situation and unemployment, inadequate legislation and its application in the field of youth and conflict with the law, insufficient knowledge of the law by the youth, inadequate funding for preventive programs and inadequately trained human resources (without training, networking and joint action), under sanctions of various groups that have a negative effect on young people (sect, extremist groups and movements).
- **3. Problems related to negative influence of peer groups:** identification with the agents of negative behavior patterns and not enough emphasis on positive role models.
- **4. Problems related to the media:** promotion of negative role models.

#### **Ecology and Sustainable Development**

- **1. The low level of knowledge about ecology and environmental protection:** The low level of environmental **awareness**, lack of formal environmental education.
- **2.** Lack of empowerment of civil society in environmental and sustainable development: insufficient number of young activists, the lack of a strategic approach and a shared vision, lack of concrete solutions and actions, the lack of support programs, lack of organization, lack of cooperation.
- **3.** Lack of support institutions and other entities to engage young people in ecology: Lack of youth involvement in decision-making processes on environmental issues, lack of respect for the law, lack of financial support programs, not enough young qualified experts in ecology who are employed in institutions.

#### 1. Necessary mechanisms for implementation and monitoring

Team to prepare a LAP, the participants of round tables (in the process of LAP) proposed the development of the Youth Office Prijepolje as structured and clearly defined services for young people - youth service in local government that will work with the Council for Youth, relevant institutions for young people, youth organizations and individuals to be active resource to daily work on the implementation, implementation and monitoring of LAP youth Prijepolje.

Adoption and implementation of LAP Prijepolje youth, our community shows responsibility towards young people which is reflected in:

- creating a clear position on long-term strategy for youth,
- creation of a municipal body to worry about solving youth

issues and problems,

- ensuring youth participation in all bodies related to youth,
- financing of youth organizations and organizations dealing with youth through funding of youth projects and programs through open competition.

### 2. The institutional framework for cooperation, organization and participation of youth in decision-making

Office for Youth was established 2 April 2008th supported by the Ministry of Youth and Sports of the Republic of Serbia. Office for Youth is a youth service in local government which will, in cooperation with local authorities, relevant institutions for youth issues, youth organizations and youth and individuals to work on implementation and monitoring of LAP youth Prijepolje

3. Youth Office Prijepolje: goals, tasks, structure

#### Objectives:

Youth Office Prijepolje is an operational body that brings together all services and agencies dealing with youth, develops plans, coordinates and coordinate actions with the aim to:

- care of the priority issues of youth while respecting the needs of young people,
- builds relationships and collaborates with local organizations and youth initiatives, public, civil society and the private sector,
- be committed to European integration and use recommendations of the European Charter on youth participation at local and regional level,
- o supports the creation of civil society.

#### Tasks of the Youth Office Prijepolje:

- In order to promote the LAP youth Prijepolje and the opportunities it provides
- Working on implementation of LAP youth Prijepolje in cooperation with relevant institutions, local governments, NGOs, youth organizations and youth and active individuals
- Implementation of monitoring processes and implementation activities for the implementation of LAP for Youth
- o Find new funding opportunities for youth programs
- Ensuring effective communication of all relevant and responsible entities for the development of young people at local and national level.

#### Structure:

- Office for Youth is made of:
- 1. Coordinator of youth
- 2. Assistant Coordinator
- 4. Council Office for Youth, 7 members (prominent and renowned representatives of local institutions and NGOs who have significant achievements in youth work). Tasks and responsibilities of the Council for Youth precisely defined rules of procedure of the Council for Youth.

Coordinator of youth should meet the following criteria:

- o be between 19 and 35 years
- Graduate or PRS
- Active in the youth sector for at least 2 years
- Has computer
- Speaks English

- Possesses the knowledge, skills and experience in writing projects; reporting; planning, implementation and coordination of various activities (seminars, study tours, conferences)
- Possess knowledge and skills of teamwork
- o Possess knowledge and skills of successful communication
- Possess knowledge and skills management of interactive processes (meetings, forums, discussions, presentations)
- Possess knowledge and skills of creating plans and programs for youth policy.

#### 4. Financing and sustainability of the Youth Office Prijepolje

Core business of the Office for Youth (space, equipment, material, part of the programcosts, salaries of coordinators and assistants) is funded by the founder of The Municipality of Prijepolje. Sustainability and Development Program of the Office of Youth Prijepolje will provide applying the relevant ministries, national and international foundations supporting projects of youth policy.

## 5. The manner of implementation of the implementation of the Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje

Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje binding municipality
Prijepolje in cooperation with the team for making LAP and the Office for Youth makes a
one-year action plans.

These annual action plans are operational plans for the year with a detailed description of activities. Annual action plans will enable meeting the needs of young people in accordance withcurrent social conditions.

From 2010. was necessary to introduce a new budget line for the implementation of the Local Action Plan for Youth Prijepolje. Through a public announcement in local mediaand Municipal Gazette will define priorities and invite all relevant stakeholders to submitthe required project documentation in accordance with the annual Action Plan.
