The integrated and sustainable development of the territories is one of the main topics of interest of CeSDA's European Area Planning Manager, Dr. Simona Zelli, who, in her ten-year experience as a European project designer and manager, had the opportunity, on the issues in question, to establish professional relationships with the major research centers and with the most innovative companies in Europe. It is no coincidence, then, that one of the first major work conducted by Cesda was related to the development of DIDonE (Distributed Integration of management for Decentralized Energy storage), Coordinator Fondazione Bruno Kessler, Trento -, candidate for funding on H2020 LCE-01 -2016-2017 - Energy, Transportation, Urban and Territorial integrated sustainable development / Smart cities. To apply for this project, CeSDA, once the object of work has been identified, has focused on identifying international partners, building partnerships, managing relations with partners during the participatory planning process, drafting the project and build the budget (3.983.500 euros).

The strategic choice was made to entrust the coordination of the project (coordinator partner) to the Fondazione Bruno Kesler of Trento and to include CeSDA in the project for the Action of its specific competence (Action related to the study of the regulatory frameworks concerning the figure of the prosumer

in the field of energy in the 3 pilot project sites - Italy, Turkey and the Netherlands, and the proposition to the European Community of a unified package of rules for the Member States).
