Background and experience

The name of our Association is **Asociația de Dezvoltare Intercomunitară Harghita** (Harghita Community Development Association), short name is ADI Harghita. ADI Harghita was founded at the initiative of Harghita County Council, on 17 December 2009. Our members are municipalities from Harghita county-Transylvania, Romania.

The objective of Asociația de Dezvoltare Intercomunitară Harghita is the establishment and development of long term cooperation with the municipalities of Harghita county, implementation of projects at national and international level which contribute to the development and promotion of the county tourism and as well to the conservation of the protected areas, therefore Asociația de Dezvoltare Intercomunitară Harghita undertakes its activities in the field of tourism, culture and environmental protection.

Our main activities are:

 Development and promotion of tourism: increasing the capacity of accessing funds regarding the development and promotion of the tourism; developing the institutional framework in the tourism sector; organizing fairs, events and tourism exhibitions in on sustainable tourism activities in protected natural areas; preparation of publications, websites, magazines; participation in thematic projects (ex. Via Mariae) and promotion



of cultural-religious tourism etc.

• Conservation of protected areas: creating studies in the field of protected areas; administration and protection of protected areas; developing programs on sustainable tourism activities in natural areas.

We organize events by ourselves or together with other partners from county in the field of tourism and culture, publish brochures about values of the county and we create programme guides for tourists.

What are the activities and experience of the organization in the areas relevant for this application?

We cooperate with several institutions and organizations in the field of youth and we organize workshops, events for young people regarding the tourism and culture. ADI Harghita gives particular attention to Youth. The Association supports them with mentoring and creates opportunities for them to participate on exhibitions, workshops and exchange of experience in Romania and abroad. Harghita County Council (elected public authority in Harghita County) declared this year for Youth, with a focus on helping young people, supporting their training, education and entertainment programs. There were organized a lot of events in the county in the name of Youth's Year: XIV. Harghita County Days, Youth Days 2018, photo competitions, cultural events, career guidance, presentations about entrepreneurship etc. ADI Harghita, operating within the legal framework of the County Council, joined to the programme and started to elaborate their own activities in the Youth sector.

ADI Harghita can contribute to all stages of the project:

- preparation, realization, dissemination and exploitation of projects' results
- selection and full preparation of the participants at local and regional level
- social research activity, in order to analyze strengths and weaknesses of the current situation in the local context
- organization of training workshops and activities to improve the level of personal and social empowerment of young people

Our association aims to develop projects related to entrepreneurial spirit of young people in tourism industry, culture and environmental protection, so the good practices of the project will



be included in our future projects.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons?

We work with many volunteers at our events that have different experience.

About Harghita County

With a total area of 6339 km2, Harghita county is situated in the central part of Romania. To the west it borders with Mureş county, to the south with Braşov and Covasna counties, to the east with Bacău and Neamţ counties, while to the north it neighbours Suceava County. Harghita County was created after the dissolvement of the Mureş-Magyar Autonomous Region during the last administrative division of the country in 1968, and lies mostly on the territory of the former Ciuc and Odorhei regions.

Besides the beauties of nature, the sites of built heritage are also popular tourist destinations. Due to its geographic position, Harghita County can be regarded as a link between East and West – both as far as its natural features and as far as the aspects of its cultural and religious life are concerned. From an ethnographic point of view, Hungarian traditions successfully blend with Romanian and – in certain regions – with Armenian traditions. The Dârjiu fortified church is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Among the other notable monuments are the Mikó Castle in Miercurea Ciuc, the Lázár Castle in Lăzarea, the Armenian Catholic church and the Armenian dwelling houses in Gheorgheni, the 'Székely-attacked fortress' in Odorheiu Secuiesc and the Moglăneşti wooden church. The interiors of several churches in the Ciuc and Odorhei regions feature mural paintings of the Saint Ladislaus legend. Ruins of medieval forts can also be visited.

Harghita County is primarily a rural area. Its main source of attraction resides in the intimate relationship of its inhabitants with nature and in the always renewing, living traditions. Folk culture and traditional husbandry practices - values that have already been forgotten in West-Europe – are part of everyday life here, which can be easily noticed while travelling across the countryside. The spectacular Szekler gates decorated with ancient motives prove that folk culture is alive in the region.

Tourists are welcome to take part in organised programs where they can be initiated in the ins and outs of pottery, weaving or wood carving, are offered the possibility to bake home-made bread or to have rides on horse-drawn carts. The traditional balls organised in the villages of Harghita County offer wonderful opportunities for learning folk dances.
