Description of the organization

Thanks to the project, many women living in rural areas gained a new income item. In addition, with our project sustainability efforts, our women had the opportunity to produce and sell products such as marmalade from this fruit they had just learned.

We created a 3D entrepreneurship education game for our young entrepreneurs with the Biz4Fun project, a strategic partnership project implemented between 2018 - 2021.

As of April 1, 2021, Naturelder successfully carried out the "Civil Society Development in Rural Areas" project (TR2016/DG/03/A3-01/018), another **EuropeAid** project within the scope of the **Civil Society Support Program III**.
