As a result, Caserón Baruca appears, accessible apartments in the Pineta Valley. An equipment consisting of ten apartments and two common rooms, Barucoteca and Baruca Zen.

Located in a privileged environment in the Aragonese Pyrenees, it is addressed to all people who want to know the [Sobrarbe](#) region and especially those who have problems when doing leisure activities and free time normalized by the lack of areas adapted to their possibilities.
