Background and experience

Please provide a short presentation of your organisation/group (usual activities, affiliations, etc) in relation to the field covered by the project.

The municipality of Lora del Río (Seville) is one of 104 municipalities from the province of Seville within Guadalquivir valley, to the east of Seville, which is about 57 kilometres away. Located in Gualdaquivir valley has strong agroindustry with citrus and vegetable. Our main experience in the field of Erasmus plus programmes is our consigned way of working with young people for more than 10 years ago. From the European office of our Council in collaboration with youth councillorship we develop many workshops to improve the abilities of this population sector. The main topics that we are working on currently are anti-discrimination, environment, integration (keeping in mind the refugee's situation around the world), intercultural dialogue, minorities and sustainable development. We prepare learning sessions to increase their knowledge about that topics; by that way, we give them a central role to define the activities, traineeships plan, courses etc. We have been developed activities about how to improve the communication abilities to interact with different cultures, also we have made courses about anti-discrimination where they worked about stereotypes, interreligious dialogue and how to integrate better migrant people in our town. We have made a course about LGTBIQ issues for university student and many people from the social sciences field came to this course. Every workshop that we have developed with these topics is a successful course because young people in our town is really interested in that, also in environmental topics. Besides, we develop many activities and workshops with youngsters to teach them how to be better citizens by giving them values to improve our society. We learn together with different educative methods inside of no n-formal education led by youth workers from the European information office of our Council. Another relevant activity is the 'European week' with international games, speaking different languages, celebrating our euro-dinner, making town tours in English and Italian, so our experience is greatly accredited by this kind of activities.

What are the activities, interest and experience of your organisation in the areas relevant to the project topic?

We have been working with young people for more than 10 years in the field of youth exchanges. In our organization, there are a lot of active young people between 13-25 years old. They are creative, funny and hardworking people who are very interested in international youth projects. Through our organization organize activities for young people, we give them information about all the international opportunities (exchanges, traineeships, scholarships, international jobs, European Solidarity Corp, fellowships etc.). Besides we try to improve their social skills and we carry out

activities to promote knowledge about Europe.

As host organization undertakes to:

- To manage all the activities of a complete timetable for a youth exchange: daily activities about the topic as role-plays, theatres, flashmob, videoblogs, web pages, youngsters' entertainment, groups' dynamics, debates, round tables, conferences, advertisement proposals, workshops, communication dynamics, trips, games, sport activities, euro dinners etc.
- Providing all the necessary elements to host partners in the best quality conditions talking about accommodation and diets.
- To prepare Youthpass to participants with the main knowledge that they have had for the exchange.
- Preparing the draft in contact with the promoter, making a Memorandum of understanding to facilitate the transfer of credits in the Common Framework ECVET.
- Development of a practical agreement for each participant.
- Foster understanding of the culture and mentality of the host country.
- Receive the participants and search tasks as decided in the project and according to the CV of participants and training needs professional.
- Assign Tasks and responsibilities of the participants to match their knowledge, skills, competencies and training objectives and ensure the proper equipment and support.
- Identify a tutor to monitor the progress of participants training.
- Provide Practical support if required.
- Fill The agreement on the quality of the partnership in the Leonardo da Vinci program.
- Fill All documentation, Europass and reports.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this project?

The municipality of Lora del Río has several projects about culture, environment, education, etc., The Mayor (Key person) has collaborated and carried out all projects, also, the Council count with a highly qualified staff with more than 1 00 employees. We have many professional profiles suitable to play a central role as youth workers in the specific field of Erasmus Plus projects. We have many professional profiles working in this type of international activities, stablishing a great collaborative work together. There are a psychologist specialised in teenagers, social workers whose main work is the social-educative intervention with young people from slums, social educators that also work with young people providing training about social skill, abilities to the common life, communicative

activities etc., also we have many sociocultural monitors that make socio-cultural activities for young's entertainment and learning. Besides we have an amazing team that works in the field of sports with young people too. The centre Guadalinfo, give formation about new technologies to improve population skills in this field and on entrepreneurial competencies.
