SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

The project "Burgos 2021" aims at creating partnerships with European associations that work on cultural heritage, to develop educational strategies based on non-formal education methods that can enhance the awareness of the relation between art, traditions, culture and the future. Erasmus+ program has been crucial in uniting Europe and has also played a vital role in sharing and preserving our diverse cultural heritage.

The choice of deepening into this topic comes from that in 2021 the city of Burgos will celebrate the 800th anniversary of its cathedral. Anniversaries of historical, social and cultural events allow us to preserve its memory but they help, above all, to give us the awareness of where we come from and where are we going, so of who we are. Young people often do not take part on these events, because very rarely they are given the opportunity to express themselves, to learn and to be personally involved.

Understanding where we come from is an opportunity for them to define where we will go for a great and united Europe in its beautiful diversity, and that is the reason why we want to establish partnerships and work to create opportunities where youngsters can learn about their past and present to more easily project their future.





The **specific objectives** of the project would be:

• bring together organisations working with young people in order to create new project ideas, develop educational strategies based on non-formal education methods;

• identify educational strategies that can bring young people closer to art, culture and tradition;

• create atmosphere of common understanding between people representing different cultures, working styles;

• present examples of efficient and successful cooperation;

build new partnerships;

• bring together experts and actors in the field in order to foster a tangible exchange of skills and experience from different cultural perspectives in the hopes of increasing the knowledge and abilities;

• to form linkages between all participants in order to promote future cooperative projects and exchanges involving not only the participants but also their beneficiaries;

• to complete the initial phase of cooperative project planning, and provide a communications network in order to ensure the completion of said projects.

Participants

The idea is that each partner organisation will involve one person from its staff that have some kind of relevant role in the organisation, with decisional powers.

Accommodation

The PBA will be held in the province of Burgos. The venue will be adequate to host the entire group.
