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Background and Experience	
<p>Please briefly describe your organization</p>	<p>Senderos de la Alpujarra youth association is an association of regional scope, of general interest and non-profit, an association based in the municipality of Bérchules, born to disseminate and promote the culture, gastronomy and youth population of the Alpujarra.</p> <p>We want to encourage exchange and relationships with other associations to promote active participation in the social and youth life of the Alpujarra region and the province of Granada, so that our and our young participants can actively participate in all kinds of activities making a great contribution for their own personal development and for the community in general.</p> <p>Our main objective is the approach to youth leisure, we intend that a comprehensive response can be given to the socio-cultural needs of youth, so that they always have the option of carrying out healthy activities and developing their personal and professional skills and abilities. Linked to this as an essential feature, we are committed to developing cooperation in the field of youth in the European Union, as we believe that this program brings many values to young people and provides unique opportunities to empower young people.</p> <p>On the one hand, as a basic instrument of our work is animation and on the other, participation in and for free time. Thus, from the Asociación Juvenil Senderos of the Alpujarra offers a wide range of programs and activities of very different nature and with diversified objectives.</p> <p>In all activities the idea of cooperation, integration, overcoming among the young participants predominates, constituting a hallmark of them. Proof of this is the important youth and volunteer movement that the province has and in which we are involved.</p> <p>Our main activities are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Management of a youth hostel in Bérchules, where young people live in the natural environment carrying out the following activities: 1. Gymkanas. 2. Workshops, courses, seminars, talks and conferences. 3. Theaters. 4. Excursions.



	<p>Cultural visits and itineraries. Hiking and creation of nature routes. 5. Projections. 6. Concerts. 7. Competitions. 8. Sports tests. 9. Volunteer programs. 10. Association meetings. 11. Outdoor camping.</p> <p>So that our activities are richer in content and media we have sought from our beginnings the collaboration with other associations, and organizations, we understand that this way of acting makes it easier for young people to meet other organizations, associations, young people, which will transmit new ways of learning, of working and knowing different realities to their surroundings collaboration with the youth centers of the whole province, especially with the Espacio Joven of Maracena and that of Albolote for the proximity to our headquarters, although we have also carried out activities in places like the Alpujarra, the Granada coast, or towns in the interior of the province.</p> <p>- Meetings of groups to promote healthy leisure, with very varied themes, and where workshops are held through which young people create great bonds of friendship in addition to providing a useful service to the community, in turn empowering their own competitions</p> <p>These are some of the main pillars for what we bet and that is why we get involved and enter into the Erasmus + Youth projects, to get to know organizations from other countries and to be able to transmit our experience and know others for the better and learn, understanding Europe as a unique space for development. Therefore, we intend to favor and strengthen cooperation between organizations from other countries, sharing values to achieve greater youth participation that is undoubtedly the future of our society and greater tolerance to the different cultures that make up a continuously changing and rich Europe of diversity through which our and our young people can increase knowledge, promote training, exchange of ideas, information and experiences, enhancing European social networks.</p>
<p>What are the activities and experience of your organisation in the areas relevant for this application?</p>	<p>Our association is new but we have the support of other associations and</p>



	<p>organizations that have a great background and experience such as the Asociación para monitores Mar Antiguo; public bodies and public administrations such as the City Hall of Maracena and the City Council of Bérchules.</p> <p>In this matter at hand, we have little experience. However, the reason we propose the creation of our organization is that we want to set different activities that enrich us and are beneficial for European citizenship. In our opinion, since we have competences in the labor branch and in the field of Youth Information, we believe that tools and mechanisms that are binding links, facilitators could be provided when undertaking actions of active job search or of a educational training in an inclusive way.</p> <p>The Asociación Juvenil Senderos de la Alpujarra, has collaborated successfully in youth exchanges, both helping in the management and in collaboration with the Espacio Joven of the City Council of Maracena, data that we believe supports us in guaranteeing the reception of a large number of participants and ensures We always try to face the objectives that we set in the various programs effectively.</p> <p>We want to add that although we are aware that we have not previously addressed this matter, we consider that we are able to make a good exchange of diversity, integration and collaboration between the participants, beneficial at the human level and in a way of personal self-knowledge.</p> <p>We have staff who have received training to provide labor, performing arts, and training with ICT (Information and Communication Technologies), who have worked with young people of special diversity and have a high degree of involvement, awareness and Awareness with youth.</p> <p>Finally, to make a point, we are a group mostly of members of the feminine gender, since we consider that it is important because in some regions and towns feminist initiatives are not yet taken, although we believe in and promote effective gender equality, We consider it equally significant that young women believe and become aware that they can promote projects that are beneficial for</p>

<p>What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons in your organization that will be involved in this project?</p>	<p>We are a fundamentally feminine organization, we want the town of Bérchules to be empowered, that the young people of the municipality wish to collaborate and take actions so that the municipality is valued and the ideal environment for activities informal education .</p> <p>From our organization, we have personnel in charge of carrying out efforts and activities throughout the year, ambientologists, monitors, professors, partners, collaborators, etc.</p> <p>Responsible for energizing the association and seeking new activities in addition to getting the largest number of participants, and also to achieve the collaboration and participation of other associations and organizations.</p> <p>The members of the association can present the activities they deem appropriate, they vote in a meeting and if it is approved it is done.</p> <p>Among the partners we have, we have for this project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Monitors for free time, qualified and experienced. - Cheerleaders, partners with experience in the animation and dynamization of meetings and activities. - Teachers, partners with the finished education career who collaborate with us in the educational projection of the project. <p>These and these partners are trained to work with various groups, especially those of young people, by having extensive training and professional experience. In their trajectory they have designed, executed and evaluated various programs of activities that have an impact on educational and social issues, while participating in the creation and development of the main resources of our association aimed at the youth population. The operational capacity of our youth association is increased by being in full collaboration with other NGOs that are involved in the objectives of these areas, such as the Cruz Roja Española, Civil</p>
