The camp provides a unique opportunity to help people in need while exploring Jordan cultures, particularly Bedouins lifestyle, historical sites and shrines.



### Camp's activities include:

- **Community Service** at school, grassroots organizations, communities and refugee camps.
- **Plant 1000 desert trees** threatened with extinction.
- **Interactive Workshops** (topics: entrepreneurship, dialogue and intercultural citizenship).
- **Interfaith visits** to religious shrines and houses of worship (ancient Churches, Mount Nebo, Jesus Christ Mosque)
- **Visit ancient ruins and historic sites** including **Petra**, **Wadi Rum**, **Crusader castle of Montreal** and **Jerash city**.
- Experience the **traditional Bedouin culture**.

**Costs of participation** (Costs to be paid in Jordan): **EURO 300** (Including transportation, food, accommodation for 7 days, Camel Riding, Wadi Rum jeep safari, and other voluntary activities' cost).

**Note:** Participants coming from overseas are requested to buy the Jordan travel pass (available online [www.jordanpass.jo](http://www.jordanpass.jo)) which cost JOD 70 (USD 99), it includes the visa fees of JOD 40 (US\$56.50) and entry to top 40 of Jordan's tourist attractions, including Petra, Jerash, Wadi Rum, and much more.
